05-01, 08-13, 1/17 It is unlawful for non-resident hunters to take or attempt to take waterfowl without first obtaining a five (5) day non-resident WMA Waterfowl Hunting Permit on all WMAs a maximum of six (6) permits per individual per waterfowl season This permit is in addition to hunting and/or guide license requirements as stated in Chapter 03.00. This permit must be in the person's possession while taking or attempting to take waterfowl on any WMAs.

PENALTY: Class 2
