

National Park College (NPC) requests a suspension of the Committee rules requiring submission of items 10 days in advance of a committee meeting to review the attached MOF's. The projects are for the renovation of the Fisher Campus Center: \$2,453,700; and for the expansion of the Laboratory Science Building: \$1,562,577.

This request to review both MOF's is needed due to an oversight at the Division in the submission of the MOF's before the holiday break. The Department of Human Services (DHS) requests a suspension of the Committee rules requiring submission of items 10 days in advance of a committee meeting to review the attached seventh amendment to contract # 710DMI7013 between DHS and Classical Optical Laboratories, Inc (Optical) for Medicaid Vision Services.

This request to review the contract amendment is needed due to an extensive search DHS has undertaken to determine whether any of our Medicaid services contracts were over the approved legislative authority amount. The Optical contract was procured through an Invitation for Bid with a start date of December 1, 2013 and will end on November 30, 2020. The legislatively approved total projected cost for the seven-year contract is \$22,057,224.70. As of January 8, 2020, the paid to date amount for the contract is \$21,492,755.59. DHS is requesting the amendment to add funds to the contract so that Optical can provide eyeglasses, lenses, frames and related articles to eligible beneficiaries of the Arkansas Medicaid program for the remainder of the duration of the contract. The Department of Human Services (DHS) requests ratification of expenses to allow payment for services provided by Classic Optical, formerly BSA Industries Inc Select Optical (Optical) for Medicaid Vision services since December 1, 2013, in addition to expenses incurred up until action in the legislature.

The legislatively reviewed total projected cost for this contract for services dated from December 1, 2013 and ending November 30, 2020 is \$22,057,224.70. The pay to date amount on January 8, 2020, was \$21,492,755.59.

This request for ratification is needed due to an extensive search DHS has undertaken to determine whether any of our Medicaid services contracts were over the approved legislative authority amount. The Optical contract was procured through an Invitation for Bid with a start date of December 1, 2013 and will end no later than November 30, 2020. The legislatively approved total projected cost for the seven-year contract is \$22,057,224.70. As of January 8, 2020, the paid to date amount for the contract is \$21,492,755.59.

Optical provides eyeglasses, lenses, frames and related articles to eligible beneficiaries of the Arkansas Medicaid program. Optical provided what, by every measure, seem to be genuine services to Arkansas during the contract period. There is no indication that Optical acted in bad

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faith or intended to act in a fraudulent manner. It is in the best interest of the State to continue to provide vision services.

DHS has developed an internal control which will ensure contract payments will not be made in excess of legislative authority. This internal control has been submitted to the Office of Inspector General for review.
