Dear Mr. Ehenger,

The Delta Cultural Center is preparing to dive into a renovation project at the Delta Cultural Center Depot in Helena. We are working with Tommy Jameson to prepare the plans and bid specifications. We are requesting to bid this project under Historic Site Law.

Just for background information, the Delta Cultural Center Depot is a former 1917 Missouri Pacific Train Depot that opened in 1990 as a museum facility. The structure is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is within the Cherry Street Historic District.

The property has been well maintained, but at this time a number of repairs need to be addressed. It is important to complete this project now before serious damage occurs. Funding for this project has been secured and we plan to complete this project within the next several months.

The scope of work to be completed includes:

- Repair to the existing clay tile roof. Repairs include selective removal of tile and felt, repair of the wood deck, and reinstallation of the existing tile. Visible areas have been identified, but extent of deterioration will not be known until removal. This is the largest work element and clearly fits the intent of the Historic Site Law.
- Front elevation planters continue to be a problem, although they are not used as planters. Water damage is apparent inside the Depot below the planters. It is suggested to cap off the planters with a flat cover.
- Installation of additional or new bird control measures. The building has had Nixolite on most bird sitting surfaces, with only marginal results. Additional measures are being explored as a solution.

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• All exterior wood surfaces will be repaired and painted. This is somewhat dependent of the amount of decking repaired on the large overhangs.

Due to the fact that we are dealing with a state owned historic property, that there are some unknowns involved in this project specifically in the roof repairs, and that the Depot is the most iconic historic structure that the Delta Cultural Center operates, the agency feels it is necessary to utilize Historic Site Law for this specific project.

Under the provisions of the State Procurement Law, Section 19-11-263, Special Procurements, this report of use of the provision is made for the Department of Corrections for July 2007:

Based on justification provided by the Arkansas Department of Correction (ADC), it is my determination that an unusual or unique situation exists that makes the application of all requirements of competitive bidding, competitive sealed bidding, or competitive sealed proposals contrary to the public interest. The provisions of this section of the Procurement Law, ACA 19-11-263, will be used in the procurement of agricultural fertilizer for ADC farms units due to the volatility in the market due to uncertainty in the petroleum industry and the construction of the Ouachita Special Needs Unit. Other provisions of the Procurement Law did not allow the flexibility required by ADC to properly purchase those items in a timely manner or at a cost most beneficial to the State.
