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This amendment is to add \$250,000 to the existing award, thereby increasing the amount of funding from \$650,000 to \$900,000 for a Workforce Investment Act Demonstration Project, focused on facilitating coordinated service delivery to members of the military, veterans, and their families, and to extend the end of the period of performance from August 31, 2012 to June 30, 2013.
