Purpose and Scope of Sub-Grant:

The focus of the Grandparent project continues to be the provision of family formation, support, preservation, stabilization, and strengthening services. Services begin with a family support assessment to determine the needs of individual families. The target attendance of programs continues to be 75% of the potential constituency of TEA-child only recipients in each of the counties served. Arkansas Voices regularly assesses and monitors each family to ensure that they receive all financial and social benefits to which they are entitled. Monthly support groups provide a forum in which grandparents can share and assist each other and children can participate in activities.

For the most part, the organization does not provide direct services; instead it serves as an advocate and resource broker (with any fees paid directly to the service providers). The agency will continue to provide support and solutions, when possible, to problems related to living arrangements, unpaid bills, employment, emotional concerns and issues related to aging.
