

**Arkansas Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA)
 FY 2012 State CASA Grants
 ACT 1032 REVIEW SUMMARY**

All local CASA programs in Arkansas recruit, train, and supervise community volunteers to advocate for the best interests of abused and neglected children in Circuit Court, Juvenile Division pursuant to A.C.A. §9-27-316(g). All programs are in compliance with state and national standards for CASA advocacy and program management. Both the National CASA Association and Arkansas CASA now require all programs to pass a rigorous quality assurance process based upon state and national standards.

State CASA grants allow local programs to pay for: salaries and related costs for program staff to recruit, supervise, and manage volunteers; necessary travel for continuing contact with children and training; providing supplies and equipment; assisting with rent, utilities, printing, audits, insurance, and membership in the National CASA Association.
