## **CURRENT SPECIAL LANGUAGE (WITH AGENCY REQUEST)**

NTI - ADDITIONAL TEACHING LOAD. Full-time staff and ten (10) extra help positions at Northwest Technical Institute, may be paid up the seventy-five dollars (\$75) per clock hour for the fiscal year ending June 30, <del>2020</del> <u>2021</u>, for noncredit teaching assignments; or up to five hundred fifty dollars (\$550) per semester hour for the fiscal year ending June 30, <del>2020</del> <u>2021</u>, for teaching courses beyond the defined teaching load; and the employee's maximum allowable salary may be exceeded by such amount; provided, however, that such additional teaching load may not exceed one hundred fifty (150) clock hours or nine (9) semester credit hours per school year. Further, the provisions of this section shall only apply to credit and noncredit courses that are funded by Private Industry.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2020}{2021}$  through June 30,  $\frac{2021}{2022}$ .
