The Arkansas Department of Transportation (Department) is requesting additional appropriation under the Department of Finance and Administration's Disbursing Officer Act 199 of 2022, Section 33. The request is for a total of \$7 million for the Fund SIS0000 Road and Bridge Repair Fund Center 83J in commitment item 510:00:04 – Grants and Aid.

This increase is needed for the purpose of disbursing Natural Gas Severance Taxes distributed to the Department for the benefit of ten counties for Road and Bridge Repair in the Fayetteville Shale area. These funds are distributed to the ten counties monthly.

During last year, the Department requested and received and increase for this appropriation from \$2 million to \$5 million. Revenue into this fund continues to increase. Therefore, we respectfully request an increase of \$5 million, which will bring the total appropriation for the Road and Bridge Repair Fund SISO000 Fund Center 83J in commitment item 510:00:04 – Grants and Aid to a total of \$7 million.

I respectfully request your approval for additional appropriation under Section 33 of Act 199 of 2022 of \$1,500,000 to the Outdoor Recreation Grant program fund for the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism – State Parks Division.

The significant increase in Real Estate Transfer Tax revenues, of which this program receives a share, has created additional funding that can be utilized to award grants for more outdoor recreation opportunities for the citizens of Arkansas.
