 The HMEP program is designed to allow grantees the flexibility to implement training and planning programs that address differing needs for each location based on demographics, emergency response capabilities, commodity flow studies, and hazard analysis. ADEM is Arkansas' designated agency to receive HMEP funds to provide training to state and local level emergency managers. Additional appropriation is needed to cover 32 partial scholarships at 200.00/each and 32 full scholarships at 800.00/each to attend the 2023 HOTZONE Conference. We currently have \$15,000 in appropriation to cover this. We are asking for an additional \$17,000. Funding is sufficient to cover this request.
