On November 7, 2025, Senator Ben Gilmore and Representative Les Eaves, Co-Chairs of the Arkansas Legislative Council, and Senator Jonathan Dismang and Representative Jeff Wardlaw, Co-Chairs of the PEER Subcommittee, received written notification from James Hudson, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, requesting emergency approval/review of requests for a Restricted Reserve Fund Transfer and related Cash Fund Appropriation.
