Dear Senator Dismang and Representative Wardlaw:

I respectfully submit the following changes to the FY2027 appropriations for the Office of the Treasurer of State:

Personal Services, Operating Expenses, and Data Processing Systems/Services
 Section (03) Appropriation - Operations - Item Number (04)(A) Operating Expense

I request an increase of \$150,000 in appropriation authority and funding from the State Central Services Fund to address increased custodial banking fees and to support ongoing operational expenses of the Office.

Justification for Operational Appropriation Request

The Bank of New York Mellon (BNY Mellon) serves as the State's custodial bank and is responsible for safeguarding and administering the State's financial assets. BNY Mellon maintains custody of the State's cash and investment holdings, processes and settles transactions, collects earnings, and provides reporting on assets held in custody. Custodial fees are assessed based on the month-end market value of assets held in custody. As a result of the Coronavirus State and Local Recovery Funds being drawn down, fees have increased due to balance of funds on hand.

Section (03) Appropriation - Operations - Item Number (07) Preparedness, Security & Safety

I request an increase of \$150,000 in appropriation authority and funding from the State Central Services Fund to support ongoing data processing system cybersecurity and business continuity measures.

Justification for Operational Appropriation Request

My Office continues to implement daily cybersecurity and business continuity improvements within the parameters of our current budget; however, the rapid growth of artificial intelligence (AI) has increased both the volume and sophistication of attempted intrusions and related risks to public funds and sensitive data. The agency has utilized the current budget to support preparation of the General Ledger system for transition to the AASIS S/4HANA platform and additional appropriation is requested to support necessary security enhancements associated with the implementation.

These requests will help ensure the continued and efficient execution of the duties of the Office of the Treasurer of State on behalf of all Arkansans. Dear Secretary McDonald:

I respectfully request your approval to transfer appropriation from the FY27 authorized DFA Disbursing Officer Appropriation authorized for Various Temporary Appropriation (VTA) for State Agencies and Institutions (Section 31 of Act 168 of 2026) to the Arkansas Securities Department (027/SDH4300/320201/CI02) in the amount of \$60,000 for salary related reimbursement expenses related to the Memorandum of Understanding currently in place between the Securities Department and the Bank Department.

The 94th General Assembly enacted Act 475 of 2023, which transferred the administrative functions of the Arkansas Securities Department (ASD) to the Arkansas State Bank Department (ASBD), amended the law concerning the organization of the Arkansas Securities Department, authorized the Bank Commissioner to also serve as the Securities Commissioner and defined the Arkansas Securities Department as an entity “...within the Arkansas State Bank Department.”

By establishing the Securities Department as an entity created within the State Bank Department and assigning the responsibility to oversee all administrative functions and activities of the Securities Department to the Bank Commissioner, Act 475 of 2023 expanded the duties required of the Bank Commissioner and certain administrative support staff that now support both the Bank Department and the Securities Department. Since FY25, the Bank Department and Securities Department have been combined into one shared appropriation act (Act 56 of 2024, Act 539 of 2025, and Act 35 of 2026), but because the appropriation act maintains a separate salary section for each department, the salary related expenses for the shared administrative support staff cannot be allocated directly in AASIS. To accommodate this restriction and to ensure the appropriate allocation of these expenses between both the Bank Department Special Revenue Fund and the Securities Department Special Revenue fund, the Bank Department and the Securities Department entered a Memorandum of Understanding that authorizes the Securities Department to reimburse the State Bank Department for the portion of time that Bank Department staff work on ASD activities.

In accordance with guidelines established by the DFA-Office of Accounting, the reimbursements are accomplished through a *budget relevant* funds transfer recorded in AASIS, which means that the funds transfers utilize ASD's appropriation authorized for Operating Expenses. This VTA Request is necessary to ensure that the Securities Department has sufficient FY27 appropriation to support this expenditure.

The Securities Department requested and received VTA appropriation for this purpose in FY25 and FY26 and will include this request in the upcoming biennial budget request (for FY28 and FY29) to eliminate the need for future VTA requests.


