

The Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) Board of Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology requests an increase for Extra Help appropriation for FY23 in the amount of \$6,000. The details of the request are as follows:

Amount: \$6,000

The Board has one full time position and one extra help position. Historically, the extra help position has been appropriated \$6,000 and used the time to prepare license renewals to assist with board meetings. The Board serves approximately 3,500 licensees, of which about 250 or 7.6% are new licensees each year, which is an approximate growth rate of 5.6%. However, due to the increasing number of licensees, additional time for the extra help is needed. Also, to better serve the needs of the Board, it would like to use the extra help position for assistance with updating records, contacting members, sending letters, and preparing conference materials. The Board is updating processes to better serve licensees and the extra help position would greatly assist the full time position in these efforts. The Board has sufficient funding for this requested increase.

We respectfully request \$1,370,201.00 in FY23 cash appropriation for the Arkansas State Veterans Homes to cover operational costs related to staffing and Residents' needs.

This request is based upon annualized FY22 actual expenditures. The Agency uses all available staffing methods, including full time, overtime, and contract labor, to ensure staffing guidelines set by the Office of Long-Term Care and the Veterans' Administration are met. Overtime costs have increased due to the nationwide nursing shortage. The agency does not expect a material change in the nursing labor market during FY23.

The acuity levels of Residents also impact expenditure levels for medical supplies, medications, and foods. This request will fulfill projected operating expenses for the Veteran Homes for the upcoming fiscal year.

Fees are collected from the Resident, Medicaid, Medicare, Veterans' Administration, and 3rd party insurance to cover the cost of these needs.

Dear Secretary Walther:

The Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage and Tourism, Arkansas Historic Preservation Program requests additional cash appropriation for FY23 under Section 28 of Act 199 of 2022, in the amount of \$87,468. The additional appropriation is necessary to accommodate the payment of regular salaries and matching of the program coordinator for the Federal and Arkansas tax credit program. Act 840 of 2021 allows the Division of Arkansas Heritage to use fees collected under the Arkansas Historic Rehabilitation Income Tax Credit Act for Personnel Costs Related to Administering the Act, and other purposes. Funding for this increase is available from existing and continuing revenues from fee collections.

The Department is requesting an increase of \$60,742 for Commitment Item 00, Regular Salaries and \$26,726 for Commitment Item 03, Personal Services Matching. For a total increase of \$87,468 in Fund NNH0440, Fund Center U45, and Business Area 0865.
