DIS is supporting an upgrade to VoIP phones and Office 365, which will increase our monthly expenses and our monthly Internet connectivity charges. These upgrades will improve our staff accessibility and response time to requests. All these changes are in alignment with the Governor's call for Boards to make licensing easier, more efficient, and readily available to military personnel.

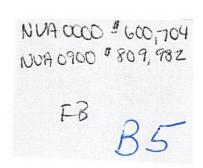

Dear Mr. Baird:

We respectfully request \$150,000 and \$90,000 for the Arkansas State Veterans Homes in North Little Rock and Fayetteville respectively in FY19 cash appropriation. These appropriations are to pay for the anticipated overtime requirements for through 31 December 2018. Since 1 July 2018, the facilities have averaged approximately \$21K and \$12K in overtime per pay period. At North Little Rock, the facility is still in a start-up phase with many scheduling irregularities and a high turnover rate that is generating the overages. At Fayetteville, the costs are associated with a registered nursing and food service provider shortages. This appropriation is critical to the operations at both facilities.

Income Certification

Certification of income to match the above requested appropriation will be made available through a transfer of Rain Day Funds on an as required basis.
