This transfer is for technical corrections that arose from AGFC receiving approval to implement the salary administration grid to adjust the Wildlife Officer salaries, the additional upgrades and reclassifications received during the biennial session, and due to the fact that AGFC did not request an increase in the above listed line items of the appropriation act to cover said increases. Commitment item, 501:00:00 per Act 238 of 2014 in the amount of \$27,226,569 for the upcoming fiscal year is less than the same commitment item, per Act 162 of 2010, \$27,452,238 for fiscal year 2011.

The Commission hereby requests transfer of \$2,500,000, in appropriation only, from capital outlay to continue funding the agency's existing workforce salary and personal services matching cost.
