The Amusement Ride Inspection Program is responsible for enforcing Arkansas's laws (ACA 23-89-502 to 518) regarding the safety of emusement rides and attractions. Arkenses law requires that the ADL amusement ride inspectors have NAARSO (National Association of Amusement Ride Safety Officials) Level 1 certification. This certification is good for only two years; however, to maintain certification, NAARSO requires that applicants have 32 CEU's of approved training during the two year period. Additionally, the Public Sector Employer Safety program is responsible for administering Arkansas' laws dealing with workplace safety and health issue in most, but not all, areas of public sector employment. Ongoing OSHA training for field inspectors is required to keep them property trained.
