Please approve the request to transfer appropriations based on our Act 922 for the 2015-2016 fiscal year in Section 20, Transfer of Appropriation.

SECTION 3. Appropriation - Unemployment Benefits and Expenses - Cash

Fiscal Year 2015-2016: \$5,000,000

SECTION 7. UI Trust Fund Interest/ Unemployment Insurance

The appropriation to be transferred is from UI benefits for tax rated employers (C29). We have a total of \$600,000,000 of appropriation, this will still leave ample appropriation for payment of UI tax rated benefits.

Act 280, Section 7 - UI Trust Fund Interest/Unemployment Insurance- TZR0000-2SF-currently has an appropriation amount of \$3,000,000. This request for an additional \$5,000,000 would increase this fund to \$8,000,000.

This additional appropriation is needed to ensure enough appropriation is in place for the "roll over" of the excess Advance Interest Funds on November 10th required by ACA§11-10-708. In order to get the excess money for the Advance Interest Trust Fund, the law requires that a warrant be created and to create a warrant there must be a sufficient appropriation.
