The additional appropriation needed for Special Needs Isolated is due to the Marvell-Elaine School District returning FY16 Special Needs Isolated funds in FY17. Because the law requires full disbursement of the Isolated (including Special Needs Isolated) funding appropriation, ADE is required to disburse those FY16 funds that were returned in FY17 to qualifying school districts.

Additional appropriation is needed for Student Growth to complete FY17 Student Growth payments to school districts pursuant to ACA 6-20-2305(c)(2)(A). Student Growth funding is calculated as the sum of one quarter of the per student founding funding amount multiplied by the increase of the district's first quarter ADM of the current year over the ADM of the previous year, and an estimation of the ADM for the second, third and fourth quarters of the current year over the ADM of the previous year. Student movement among school districts can cause Student Growth funding to calculate above the appropriated level.
