Dear Senator Davis and Representative Wooten:

The Office of Personnel Management (OPM) submits a request from the Arkansas Department of Public Safety (DPS), Division of Arkansas State Crime Lab, for your review.

DPS requests to establish a labor market rate of \$350,000 for the classification of L004N, Crime Lab Associate Medical Examiner, MP09, and increase four (4) incumbent's salary to the below-requested rates. This request is granted authority by Arkansas Code Annotated 21-5-209 (g)(2)(ii) wherein it states:

"The Office of Personnel Management may establish the salary of a specialized physician position or classification that is up to fifty percent (50%) above the maximum pay level for the grade assigned to the classification."

JUSTIFICATION

DPS states that the current starting salary is far too low, as cited by multiple applicants, to attract candidates to this classification. The Arkansas State Crime Lab currently is on their third year of probationary accreditation due to a limit of no more than 250 autopsies per doctor per year being exceeded as they cannot attract candidates. In January 2025, the Arkansas State Crime Lab performed 152 autopsies. This sets them up to exceed the accreditation's ratio of autopsies performed per doctor causing them to lose accreditation entirely. The Arkansas State Crime Lab believes that this Labor Market Rate will allow them to bring in future medical examiners at a starting salary of \$300,000 and have the flexibility to pay up to the requested rate of \$350,000 for those with specialties or extensive experience. The turnover rate for this classification was 16.67% within the past year. The total cost to increase these salaries to the requested Labor Market Rate would be approximately \$247,942, including matching. These funds will be 100% from General Revenue.

OPM has reviewed this request from DPS and **recommends** the establishment of a labor market rate for the classification of L004N, Crime Lab Associate Medical Examiner, MP09, and to bring the four incumbents listed above to the salaries indicated in the table. DPS guarantees our office that it has sufficient funding to support this request.

RE: Medical Examiner Pay

Ms. Barnhill:

The Arkansas Department of Public Safety (DPS), division of Arkansas State Crime Lab (ASCL) would like to request salary increases for the doctors in the medical examiner's office. Three of the four would increase to \$350,000 and one would increase to \$300,000. This would then allow ASCL to recruit with an entry salary of \$300,000 up to \$350,000 based on credentialing. This is in accordance with ACA 21-5-209(g)(2)(A)(ii). Below are the affected employees with costing:

Recently, Crime Lab was able to bring on a deputy medical examiner who will start in March. She has been working to recruit additional personnel, with no success. All have indicated that the starting salary is too low. Another issue coupled with that is that there were 1800 autopsies performed last calendar year with 6 doctors performing those autopsies. That equates to 300 autopsies per year per doctor. The accrediting body, NAME, allows no more than 250 autopsies per year per doctor. For each doctor performing more than the 250 autopsies, there will be a phase I violation. After 15 phase I violations, the medical examiner's office will lose accreditation. If any doctor performs more than 325 autopsies in a year, the office will receive a phase II violation which will result in the immediate loss of accreditation.

In January of 2025, the medical examiner's office performed 152 autopsies. This sets them on pace to perform 1800+ autopsies again this year. The above doctors all have either 10+ years of experience as medical examiners or hold a specialty certification that makes them highly sought after. This will be funded through General Revenue and crime lab has sufficient funding for the request.
