- (b) Salaries for agency head, agency director, or head of institution positions shall be exempt from the classification and compensation plan, and the maximum annual salary rate shall be authorized in the respective appropriation act, except as provided in § 21-5-211.

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SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-5-208(b), concerning the classification of state salaries, is amended to read as follows:

(b) The following classification titles with grades indicated are approved for the state classification plan, subject to the appropriation acts for the various state agencies and various institutions affected by this subchapter:

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 21-5-211(b)(1), concerning state employee compensation, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(l)(A) The maximum annual rate of compensation for which an employee is eligible on July 1, 2014 July 1, 2015, shall be determined by increasing the employee's June 30, 2014 June 30, 2015, salary by one percent (1%) the cost of living adjustment authorized by the Governor for all classified employees.

by the Eighty Ninth Ninetieth General Assembly for nonclassified positions may be increased by one percent (1%) the cost of living adjustment authorized by the Governor for all classified employees, and the resulting salary shall

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3	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 21-5-211(b)(4), concerning state employee
4	compensation, is amended to read as follows:
5	(4)(A) An employee compensated at the highest pay level rate
6	authorized for the grade assigned to his or her classification may receive
7	the July 1, 2014 July 1, 2015, salary increase of one percent (1%) authorized
8	in this section as a lump-sum payment.
9	(B) However, the salary increase shall be paid as a lump
10	sum on the last pay period of the $\frac{2015}{2016}$ fiscal year, and the payment
11	shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary of the employee.
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13	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 21-5-211(c), concerning state employee
L 4	compensation, is amended to read as follows:
15	(c)(l) An employee covered by this subchapter including a
l 6	nonclassified employee is eligible for an additional salary increase of two
17	percent (2%) each fiscal year upon approval by the Governor if:
18	(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State determines that
19	sufficient general revenues become available; and
20	(B) The additional salary increase of two percent $(2\%)$
21	does not result in an employee's compensation exceeding the maximum pay level
22	amount set out for the position unless the employee is eligible for the
23	career pay level on the career service pay plan as established in § 21-5-214.
24	(2)(A) An employee compensated at the highest pay level rate
25	authorized for the grade assigned to his or her classification is eligible to
26	receive the salary increase of two percent (2%) authorized in this section as
27	a lump-sum payment.
28	(B) However, the increase shall be paid as a lump sum on
29	the last pay period of the fiscal year of the year in which the increase is
30	to occur, and the payment shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum
31	salary.
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33	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 21-5-219 is repealed.
34	21-5-219. Nonelassified employees.
35	(a) An employee compensated with the maximum annual salary rate as set
36	out in dollars by law enacted by the General Assembly for a department,

1	board, commission, or state agency is cligible to receive an additional
2	salary increase of two percent (2%) each fiscal year, provided that the Chief
3	Fiscal Officer of the State determines that sufficient general revenues
4	become available.
5	(b) -A nonclassified employee compensated at the highest pay rate
6	authorized for his or her position shall be eligible to receive the salary
7	increase authorized in this section, but the increase shall be paid as a lump
8	sum on the last pay period of the fiscal year of the year in which the
9	increase is to occur.
10	(c) Lump-sum payments made under this section shall not be construed
11	as exceeding the maximum salary.
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13	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
14	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the state salary
15	classification schedules must be updated and revised; that the fiscal year
16	for state employees begins each July 1: and that this act is essential and
17	immediately necessary to implement the Uniform Classification and
18	Compensation Act, § 21-5-201 et seq., and to ensure the continued and
19	uninterrupted operation of state government and state government services.
20	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for
21	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
22	effective on July 1, 2015.
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
