## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2018; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas State Medical Board for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas State Medical Board for the 2017-2018 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Medical Board, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas State Medical Board, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas State Medical Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the following:

SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS. The State Medical Board is hereby authorized to expend from monies authorized herein, $\$ 25$ from each licensed physician licensed by the State Medical Board each year to be paid by the State Medical Board to 501(c)(3) Arkansas foundations that have healthcare professionals on their board and provide for identification, treatment and monitoring of healthcare professionals who suffer from alcohol or drug abuse problems, in order to promote the public health and safety and to insure the continued availability of skilled and highly trained medical professionals for the benefit of the public.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,2016 2017 through June 30, 20172018.

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefore, if:
(1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and
(2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the legal counsel to be retained by the agency, and
(3) The Attorney General receives confirmation in writing from the agency that the agency will re-advertise annually for legal counsel if outside legal counsel is hired and that any amount to be paid for outside legal counsel will receive prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD TO EMPLOY AN EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD AND A DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD TO EMPLOY AN EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD AND A DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-95-301(f), concerning the creation of the Arkansas State Medical Board, is amended to read as follows:
(f) (1) The members of the board may receive expense reimbursement and stipends in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.
(2) The Executive Sectetary Director of the Arkansas State Medical Board and the Deputy Director of the Arkansas State Medical Board shall receive such additional salary as may be fixed by the board.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-95-303(3) and (4), concerning the powers and duties of the Arkansas State Medical Board, is amended to read as follows:
(3)(A)(i) Have authority to employ attorneys to represent the
board in all legal matters at for a compensation approved by the board.
(ii) Contracts for employment of attorneys shall be filed by the Executive Secretary Director of the Arkansas State Medical Board with the Legislative Council.
(B) The board shall further have authority to request the assistance of the Attorney General and the prosecuting attorneys of Arkansas in such manner as it deems necessary and proper;
(4) Have the authority to employ an executive secretary director and a deputy director to carry out the purposes and the mandates of the board and to supervise the other employees of the board;

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-95-304(b)(2), concerning inspectors of prescriptions, orders, and records, is amended to read as follows:
(2) The inspectors shall have the duty and authority upon written direction by the Executive Secretary Director of the Arkansas State Medical Board to investigate, inspect, and make copies of the records, orders, and prescriptions, wherever located, of all persons licensed by the board in order to determine whether or not the persons have:
(A) Violated the laws of the State of Arkansas or of the United States respecting the prescription and use of narcotics and potentially dangerous drugs;
(B) Practiced their profession in such a way as to endanger the general health and welfare of the public; or
(C) Violated the provisions of the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq., and § 17-95-401 et seq.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-95-305(b), concerning disposition of funds of the Arkansas State Medical Board, is amended to read as follows:
(b) (1) All moneys received by the board shall be disbursed by the Chair of the Arkansas State Medical Board or the Executive Secretary Director of the Arkansas State Medical Board.
(2) The chair or the executive secretary director, or both, shall furnish a surety bond and should shall keep a true and faithful account of all moneys received and all moneys expended.
(3) The executive secretary director shall file annually with
the Governor a report of all financial transactions duly audited by an independent accountant.

SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 17-95-501(b)(3), concerning legislative intent of the subchapter on critical medical shortage areas, is amended to read as follows:
(3) It is the further intent of this subchapter that neither the board nor the Executive Secretary Director of the Arkansas State Medical Board, when acting in behalf of the board and under authority granted to him or her by the board, shall be liable, collectively or individually, for civil damages from claims pertaining to the administration of this subchapter.

SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § $17-95-505$ is amended to read as follows:
17-95-505. Nonliability of board.
In the application of the authorities and provisions of this subchapter, neither the Arkansas State Medical Board, either individually or collectively, nof and the Executive Secretary Director of the Arkansas State Medical Board, when acting on behalf of the board, shall be held are not liable for civil damages from claims pertaining to the administration of the provisions of this subchapter.

SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 17-99-305(a), concerning temporary permits of respiratory care practitioners, is amended to read as follows:
(a) In cases of emergency, the Executive Secretary Director of the Arkansas State Medical Board may issue a temporary permit without examination to practice respiratory care to persons who are not licensed in other states, but who otherwise meet the qualifications for licensure set out in this chapter.
