On Page 40, immediately following SECTION 69, insert a new SECTION to read as follows:

"SECTION 70. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSASE CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. <u>BUFFALO</u> <u>RIVER WATERSHED GRANTS AND PROJECTS. The Department of Agriculture shall</u> <u>budget, allocate, and expend five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) in</u> <u>grants for projects to the Buffalo River Watershed Grants and Projects line</u> <u>item in the Agriculture Cash Operation Fund appropriation section, to be used</u> <u>exclusively to award grants for projects in the Buffalo River Watershed.</u>

The provision of this section shall be in affect only from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026."

It is the intent of the General 12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 13 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 14 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 19

20 SECTION 72. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 21 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 22 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of 24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 25 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm 26 27 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 28 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 29 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 30 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025. 31

Amend Senate Bill 81 as originally introduced:

Page 15, immediately following Section 23, insert a new SECTION to read as follows:

"SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. <u>FUNDING TRANSFER - BUFFALO RIVER WATERSHED GRANTS AND PROJECTS. Immediately</u> upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the <u>Auditor of the State the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) from</u> the Tourism Development Trust Fund to the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury operated by the Department of Agriculture to provide funds for the Department of Agriculture to award grants for projects in the Buffalo River watershed.

No Tobacco Settlement funds or appropriations may be reallocated pursuant to this section.

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for institutions of higher education and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that institutions of higher education may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to institutions of higher education authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS - DIVISION OF CORRECTION DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.

Amendment No. ____ to Senate Bill 354

Amend Senate Bill 354 as originally introduced:

Page 1, immediately following SECTION 1, insert new sections that read as follows:

11

SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>APPROPRIATION EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION.</u> (a) The appropriation titled "Capital Improvement Projects" for costs associated with prison construction in Section 1 of this Act shall only be able to be budgeted, allocated or expended under the following conditions;

(1) The General Assembly establishes a Restricted Reserve Fund Set-Aside for "Prison Construction" in an amount no less than seven hundred fifty million dollars (\$750,000,000);

(A) The funds that make up the Restricted Reserve Fund Set-Aside for "Prison Construction" shall not originate, be diverted from, or transferred from the Catastrophic Reserve Fund or the Arkansas Reserve Fund Set-Aside in the Restricted Reserve Fund;

(B) Funds for the Set-Aside for "Prison Construction" may originate from earnings from the Securities Reserve Fund and other unobligated revenues as determined by the General Assembly other than those set out in (a)(l)(A); and

(C) The Restricted Reserve Fund Set-Aside for "Prison Construction" shall require prior approval of the greater of three-fifths (3/5) of the guorum present or a majority of the membership of the Legislative Council or,

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if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee as set out in 19-5-1263(c).

(2) The General Assembly establishes a Restricted Reserve Fund Set-Aside for "Prison Construction or Contingency" in an amount no less than two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000);

(A) The funds that make up the Restricted Reserve Fund Set-Aside for "Prison Construction or Contingency" shall not originate, be diverted from, or transferred from the Catastrophic Reserve Fund or the Arkansas Reserve Fund Set-Aside in the Restricted Reserve Fund;

(B) Funds for the Set-Aside for "Prison Construction or Contingency" may originate from earnings from the Securities Reserve Fund and other unobligated revenues as determined by the General Assembly other than those set out in (a)(2)(A); and

(C) The Restricted Reserve Fund Set-Aside for "Prison Construction or Contingency" shall require prior approval of the greater of three-fifths (3/5) of the quorum present or a majority of the membership of the Legislative Council or, if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee as set out in 19-5-1263(c).

(b) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation, funding and construction projects for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by funds set-aside for projects, delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency, and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Department of Corrections may operate more efficiently if some funds are setaside with the ability to disburse funds as needed during the interim to provide flexibility to the Department. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section and the associated appropriation is void.

(c) The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.
