The preliminary recommendations and report shall be completed within six months of the subcommittee's initial meeting. Upon completion of this preliminary report, the subcommittee shall provide the department, the

Governor, and the Arkansas Legislative Council with a report to include recommendations and desired metrics with expected timelines of completion to meet the desired outcomes provided in the preliminary report. Page 39, immediately following Section 73 insert a new section as follows: SECTION 74. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 12, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

19-5-1288. Drug Task Force Fund.

(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous fund to be known as the "Drug Task Force Fund."

(b) The fund shall consist of:

(1) Moneys obtained from public or private grants or other sources that are designated to be credited to the fund; and

(2) Any other revenues authorized by law.

(c) The moneys in the fund shall be used to distribute funds to all drug task forces in the state that meet the eligibility criteria for a disbursement and shall be disbursed to eligible drug task forces in the state by the Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration.

(d) To be eligible to receive a disbursement from the fund, a drug task force shall:

(1) Meet the standards of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training;

(2) Provide an annual accounting of its seizures and arrests to
