Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 30

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF MEDICAL SERVICES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR.

Amendment No. to Senate Bill No. 30

Amend Senate Bill No. 30 as originally introduced:

One page 12, immediately following SECTION 14, insert the following:

- SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL, AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS WORKS PROGRAM TRANSITION TO ARKANSAS MEDICAID PROGRAM.
- (a) As used in this section, "Arkansas Works Program" means the program established under the Arkansas Works Act of 2016, § 23-61-1001 et seq.
- (b)(1) Determining the maximum number of employees, the maximum amount of appropriation, for what purposes an appropriation is authorized, and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly.
- (2) The purposes of subdivision (b)(1) of this section are typically accomplished by:
 - (A) Identifying the purpose in the appropriation act:
- (B) Delineating such maximums in the appropriation act for a state agency; and
- (C) Delineating the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.
- (3) It is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly restrict the use of appropriations authorized in this act.
- (c) On and after December 31, 2018, the Department of Human Services shall take necessary action, including without limitation submitting and applying for a state plan amendment or waiver, to obtain federal approval for the transfer of the population served under the Arkansas Works Program to the traditional Arkansas Medicaid Program.
- (d)(1) If the department is unable to secure the approvals requested under subsection (c) of this section before January 1, 2019, then the department shall not allocate, budget, expend, or utilize appropriations

under this act for the participation of persons in the Arkansas Works Program.

- (2) Subdivision (d)(1) of this section does not prohibit the payment of expenses incurred before January 1, 2019, by persons participating in the Arkansas Works Program who were determined to be more effectively covered through the traditional Arkansas Medicaid Program.
- (e) All moneys placed into the Arkansas Works Program Trust Fund shall be transferred to the Arkansas Medicaid Program Trust Fund on January 1, 2019, to provide for the state match payments for the population served under the Arkansas Works Program that is transferred to the traditional Arkansas Medicaid Program. "

- (2) Subdivision (e)(1) of this section does not apply to certified application counselors at health related institutions, including without limitation the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences.
- (f) An appropriation authorized by the General Assembly shall not be subject to the provisions allowed through reallocation of resources or transfer of appropriation authority for the purpose of transferring an appropriation to any other appropriation authorized for the Department of Human Services to be allocated, budgeted, expended, or utilized in a manner prohibited by this section.
- (g) The provisions of this section are severable, and the invalidity of any subsection or subdivision of this section shall not affect other provisions of the section that can be given effect without the invalid provision.
 - (h) This section expires on June 30, 2018 2019.

SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

SEVERABILITY. If any provisions of this act or the application of this act to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
