Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 30

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF MEDICAL SERVICES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR.

Amendment No. ____ to Senate Bill No. 30

Amend Senate Bill No. 30 as originally introduced:

On page 12, immediately following SECTION 14, insert the following:

- SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL, AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF APPROPRIATION FOR ARKANSAS WORKS PROGRAM.
- (a) As used in this section, "Arkansas Works Program" means the Arkansas Works Program established under the Arkansas Works Act of 2016, § 23-61-1001 et seq.
- (b)(1) Determining the maximum number of employees, the maximum amount of appropriation, for what purposes an appropriation is authorized, and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly.
- (2) The purposes of subdivision (b)(l) of this section are typically accomplished by:
 - (A) Identifying the purpose in the appropriation act;
- (B) Delineating such maximums in the appropriation act for a state agency; and
- (C) Delineating the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.
- (3) It is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly restrict the use of appropriations authorized in this act.
- (c)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section, on and after December 31, 2018, the Department of Human Services shall not allocate, budget, expend, or utilize appropriations under this act for services, coverage, or premium assistance for persons enrolled in the Arkansas Works Program after December 31, 2018.
- (2) The department may renew enrollment for an individual enrolled in the Arkansas Works Program before December 31, 2018, if the individual meets and has continuously met all eligibility requirements and the Federal Medical Assistance Percentage for the enrollees does not drop

below the percentages established by section 1905(y) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1396d, as it existed on January 1, 2018, or by the rules of the department.

- (d) An appropriation authorized by this act is not subject to the provisions allowed through reallocation of resources or transfer-of-appropriation authority if the reallocation or transfer results in transferring an appropriation to any other appropriation authorized for the department to be allocated, budgeted, expended, or utilized for services, coverage, or premium assistance in the Arkansas Works Program that is prohibited by this section.
- (e) The department shall submit and seek approval for appropriate state plan amendments or federal waivers, or both, to eliminate the eligibility for qualified family members and individuals as described under 42 C.F.R. § 435.119, as it existed on January 1, 2018.

- (2) Subdivision (e)(1) of this section does not apply to certified application counselors at health related institutions, including without limitation the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences.
- (f) An appropriation authorized by the General Assembly shall not be subject to the provisions allowed through reallocation of resources or transfer of appropriation authority for the purpose of transferring an appropriation to any other appropriation authorized for the Department of Human Services to be allocated, budgeted, expended, or utilized in a manner prohibited by this section.
- (g) The provisions of this section are severable, and the invalidity of any subsection or subdivision of this section shall not affect other provisions of the section that can be given effect without the invalid provision.
 - (h) This section expires on June 30, 2018 2019.

SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

SEVERABILITY. If any provisions of this act or the application of this act to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
