INTERVIEW OF SUBJECT

On Wednesday June 25, 2025, I interviewed Thomas Hurst at the ADC North Central Unit. Hurst is identified as the Warden of the NCU. The below is an interview summary, it is not intended to be a verbatim account and does not memorialize all statements made during the interview. Communications by the parties in the interview were electronically recorded. A copy of the recording will be included in the case file.

Hurst advised that throughout the notification packet used during Grant Hardin's escape, his signatures indicate that he reviewed the information documented. Hurst said that the first person he notified of the escape was Lieutenant Steven Lively, supervisor of the dog kennel, followed by Deputy Director Aundrea Culclager. Hurst said that all other notifications would be handled by subordinates. Hurst explained the three levels of directives as follows:

Secretarial Directives

Administrative Directives

Unit Directives

Hurst said that the unit directives must go hand in hand with the administrative and secretarial directives. Hurst said that during the escape, he discovered that the North Central Unit's policy had been changed to reflect that the Pine Bluff Radio Room would be responsible to make notifications on "Attachment #1," which contains the management team and all external law enforcement agencies. Hurst acknowledged that the policy was incorrect. Hurst said that they traced the incorrect policy as far back as 2008. Hurst said that he became the Warden of the NCU in July of 2024. Hurst said that the only external law enforcement notifications that were made by the NCU during the escape were the Izard County Sheriff's Office and the Baxter County Sheriff's Office. When asked why external law enforcement agencies were not notified, Hurst said "I think the problem really originated from miscommunication between myself, Lieutenant Cross, and Captain Brandon." Hurst said that Cross asked Brandon if the notifications had been made, which prompted Brandon to ask Hurst if the notifications had been made. Hurst said that he told Brandon "yes" because he had notified the duty director (Culclager). Hurst said "we weren't clear on the question have the notifications been made? We weren't clear on that part." Hurst said that they discovered that they hadn't notified external law enforcement agencies the day following Hardin's escape. Hurst said that the NCU policies do not get reviewed by anyone else past the Warden. When asked if he had input on improvements to make things run more smoothly in the future, Hurst said "when something like this happens, we need to put a person on a task and make sure they've completed that one task instead of getting pulled three different ways." Hurst also stated "I just think that people here have not seen enough."

At the conclusion of the interview, Hurst provided me with the scribed notes from the command center from 5/25/25 through 6/6/25, as well as the notification list for local residents. The notifications to local residents were made by Corporal Jason Lundry, as indicated by his initials "JL." Lundry wrote "NC" or "C" after his initials for each resident to
