SPECIAL AGENT NOTES

On July 7, 2025, I, Special Agent Mike McNeill, received an email from Susan Townsend, Internal Affairs Manager for the Arkansas Department of Corrections, in which she provided the Internal Affairs investigative file concerning the escape of inmate Grant Hardin. It is noted that IA Manager Townsend authored a document titled the *NCU Escape Inquiry*, a seven-page memorandum summarizing the findings of the investigation. Within this memorandum, Ms. Townsend references the North Central Unit policy manual, specifically citing Policy NCU 9.03.0, Security and Control, Letter H, Section 1. Based on the findings set forth in the inquiry, it appears that Warden Thomas Hurst was found to be in violation of the aforementioned policy. The inquiry concludes that Warden Hurst, by virtue of being physically present when Master Control was designated as the command center, assumed the role of “ultimate commander” from the onset of the incident. Despite his presence, Warden Hurst identified Captain Brandon as the initial commander—a delegation that, according to the inquiry, was improper under policy due to the Warden’s on-site authority and command responsibility at the time.

The investigative file compiled by the Arkansas Department of Corrections (ADC) Internal Affairs Division regarding the escape of inmate Grant Hardin will be formally submitted to Deputy Director of Institutions, William Straughn, for administrative review. The purpose of this referral is to allow Deputy Director Straughn to evaluate the findings and determine whether disciplinary action is warranted against any member(s) of the North Central Unit (NCU) administration. This review will include, but is not limited to, an assessment of potential policy violations, failures in supervisory oversight, and deficiencies in emergency response protocols as outlined in ADC and NCU policy manuals.

The (ADC) Internal Affairs investigative file will be attached to this report. The noted email from Susan Townsend, Internal Affairs Manager for the Arkansas Department of Corrections, will also be attached to this report.

REFERRAL CHRONOLOGY: On May 25, 2025, information was received that Inmate Grant Hardin escaped at approximately 3:00 PM from the North Central Unit. An Emergency count was conducted, and Warden Hurst was notified of information surrounding the escape. Emergency Procedures and Checklist notifications for an Escape were expedited, Law Enforcement Emergency Call Out Procedures began, verification of missing inmate was confirmed, the "On Call Director was contacted, as well as Director Payne, and Secretary Wallace, Communications, K-9, Internal Affairs and other undetermined staff were notified.



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Internal Affairs Investigation:

On May 25, 2025, Investigator Melody Case along with Internal Affairs Administrator, Thomas Rowland arrived at the North Central Unit to assist in the search for Inmate Grant Hardin ADC#168541.

Inmate Hardin escaped from the North Central Unit/facility on foot leaving through the Sallyport back Gate, in what appeared to be a "makeshift uniform".

NCU Escape Hardin 5/25/25-5/26/25 Internal Affairs Initial Interviews

Synopsis:

Inmate Grant Hardin was assigned as the chemical issuance inmate. He worked in the kitchen, issuing chemicals for cleaning and tools and keeping logs. Inmate Hardin schedule provided for him to come in sometime after 8:30 AM. Inmate Hardin was scheduled off work on Thursday and Friday.

Internal Affairs Initial Interviews by IAD Thomas Rowland/Investigator Melody Case:

Inmate Aaron Duncan ADC#166488: Internal Affairs staff interviewed Inmate Aaron Duncan ADC#166488, who is housed in #5-bk, and is assigned as a Kitchen Bakery worker. Inmate Duncan was asked general questions concerning any information concerning the escape of Inmate Grant Hardin. Inmate Duncan stated that on 5/25/25 Inmate Hardin "seems quiet today". Inmate Duncan said he came to work on Sunday 5/25/2025 and that they (he and inmate Hardin) had no interaction on Saturday. Inmate Duncan advised that Inmate Hardin issues chemicals, he does not mention family. Inmate Duncan stated, ***"Someone in the barracks stated that Inmate Hardin had received a phone call and looked like he was upset"***. Inmate Duncan stated that Inmate Hardin has a CPAP machine, and ***"has inhalers and is seen running up and down stairs for 4 hours"***. Inmate Duncan stated that he heard that inmate Hardin's ***"Wife had talked about leaving him, He was crying on Thursday, and His daughter wasn't talking to him."*** Inmate Duncan said ***they visited a few weeks ago."*** He stated that ***"Inmate Hardin was moody."*** Inmate Duncan also said, ***inmate Hardin typically cleans the cage on Sunday afternoons"***. Inmate Duncan stated that inmate Hardin ***felt like he was not going to get out of prison"***. Inmate Duncan said that Inmate Hardin is an inmate that most people avoid because he is hard to work with."

Inmate Duncan stated that ***"on Saturday or Sunday Inmate Hardin told the kitchen supervisor that he needed to go out to the chemical cage; a locked caged area on the kitchen back dock, (an outside storage area for excess supplies, rubber boots, soap, other articles- like an overflow storage area.)"*** Inmate Duncan stated that Inmate Hardin liked working ***"typically on Sunday, to avoid working with other inmates"***. The officer opens the door and lets the inmates out the back door to work. The 1-D inmates dump the trash with an officer present. Inmate Duncan advises he does not leave the kitchen; the officer will go and check on Inmate Hardin. Typically, Corporal DeValle



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opens the door to let Inmate Hardin outside, and opens the door of the Chemical Cage for the Janitor/Porter. Inmate Hardin cleans the chemical room and then knocks on the door when he is ready to come back in. Inmate Duncan stated that he has only been housed in #5 barracks, and has worked the same area, but has no connection to him inside the facility, and there is no connections to inmate Hardin on the outside, and He did not have knowledge of Inmate Hardin's plan to escape.

Corporal William Walker Tower officer: On 5/25/25 Corporal Walker was assigned to restrictive housing for the first half of the day, then reassigned to the West Tower to relieve an officer that had gotten sick at work. (log reads 10:30 AM) Somewhere between 11:00 -12:00 Noon the rover picked up the sick officer (Cpl. John Horton) and left for the day. Corporal Walker took control of the tower; he noticed the Boiler Room Inmate checking the Boiler room with an Officer approximately every hour. Cpl. Walker said It rained heavily and thundered and there was a lot of radio traffic. He remembered that "someone came out about 3:00, it appeared to be staff knocking on the gate with a cart. He opened the first sallyport gate, then opened the second gate to let what he thought was staff out of the gate towards the ICC garage. The person at the gate with a cart was wearing a blackish hat, sunglasses on top of his hat, vest, dart shirt and pants, black boots". Corporal Walker stated, "he did not recognize the officer, as he usually works in restrictive housing". The person pushed the cart to the first gate and stated "**GATE**", he popped him through, he then went to the second gate and walked towards the ICC Garage, "**he heard the phone ring**", turned to answer it, and did not see the person when he turned around. At this time, he yelled out toward the ICC Garage "**Hey you**", the person could not be seen any more. Corporal Walker stated he then was called on the radio by Sergeant Devalle who asked him "**if he had seen his inmate**". Corporal Walker advised "**he had not seen an inmate** (a person wearing white)". He looked around and stated he had a "weird feeling when he no longer saw the staff with the cart and called Sergeant Drinkard advising him that a guy walked out with a cart, but that he could no longer see him". Corporal Walker stated he called Corporal Teegarden and said, "**he could not see the staff**"? He asked Corporal Teegarden "**if he had let an officer through laundry**", Corporal Teegarden stated, that "**he had not**". Inmate Walker then called Sergeant Drinkard (acting Lieutenant). He looked in all directions then Sergeant Drinkard, Sergeant Valentine, Sergeant Queen (Quin?), walked through Sally port, Lt. Lively drove around with the dogs and Corporal Walker advised, **the guy that looked like an officer, and that I can't see him anymore**".

2nd interview with Corporal William Walker: On May 28, 2025, Corporal William Walker (AASIS [REDACTED]) was interviewed by Internal Affairs Manager, Susan Townsend, and Internal Affairs investigator Melody Case. Corporal Walker was asked to recall how he exited the building on his way to the tower, and what had occurred, explain his post operations, and the process. It was noted on Corporal Walker's log that Corporal Walker had made "minimal visual security checks, saw one inmate come out to dump a mop bucket and go back in, and that he did not log radio traffic". Corporal Walker replied, on 5/25/25 Corporal John Horton, who was working West Tower, got sick, Corporal Walker was told to go to relieve Corporal Horton. He exited through the laundry, as inmates were taking out the trash, walked through sallyport, through both gates, climbed up the tower and took over the on 5/25/25 post. It had been raining and the windows fogged up, so he turned on the heat for a few minutes and un-fogged the glass. During the interview Corporal Walker was asked if during visitation inmates are allowed out. Corporal Walker stated, He really didn't know; Inmates do come out early before visitation (dog kennel, horse barn etc....). Corporal Walker said there was a sallyport officer working the AM shift that day (Corporal Raymond), and when he arrived at sally port and relieved Corporal Horton, Corporal Raymond locked the sally port, turned the keys into him, and Corporal Raymond drove Corporal Horton around the front, and did not return.

Corporal Walker was interviewed on the day of the incident/ 5/25/25, and then a second interview for further clarification of the chain of events, he was then administered a CVSA: Corporal Walker has been truthful and cooperative to the best of his ability, he is very visibly shaken, has taken the brunt of fault for letting this inmate out. This was a terrible mistake, he has apologized profusely, he adamantly stated ***"he believed this was an officer taking a cart out to ICC garage, pallets and cardboard were on cart."***

Corporal William Walker was working West Tower on 5/25/25 **10:30 AM- 5:21 PM**
Corporal William Walker - **2nd Interview and CVSA / NDI** Additional statement taken

Cpl. William Walker was Placed on Administrative Leave on 5/25/25, investigation pending.

FPS Justin Devalle: stated that he came to work and called for the PM Kitchen Inmates. His supervisor Captain Grady called and asked him to correct his time, at which point he asked Captain Grady if he was supposed to let Inmate Grant Hardin go back to clean the chemical cage, and if they had been assigned the 1-D inmates, in which he advised that the captain replied, ***"Business as Usual"***, which he took as ***"letting Inmate Hardin do his regular Sunday routine cleaning of the Chemical cage"***. FPS DeValle stated at **1:58 PM**, he was supervising inmates in the kitchen, when he allowed Inmate Hardin to exit to the back dock of the kitchen to clean the chemical cage on the back dock ***"unsupervised"*** At approximately 3:08 PM, FPS Delvalle stated he went to the



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back dock to look for Inmate Hardin but was unable to find him, at which time he called Corporal A. Teegarden who was working in Laundry and asked if he had let Inmate Hardin in through the Laundry backdoor, to which he stated, "he had not". They both then went to look for Inmate Hardin but were unable to find him, at which time he stated he called West Tower, Officer Corporal William Walker was on that post, he then asked if he had seen his Kitchen inmate, Inmate Grant Hardin, Corporal Walker stated, "**he had not**". After a few minutes, Corporal Walker called Sergeant Drinkard. FPS Devalle then went back to the back dock and looked in the boiler room, and upon not seeing any sign of Inmate Hardin contacted Sergeant K. Drinkard at 3:08 PM, then at 3:16 PM FPS De Valle advised Sgt. Drinkard that he could not find Inmate Hardin.

CVSA examination of FPS Justin Devalle: A secondary interview of FPS J. Devalle was conducted on May 28, 2025, by Internal Affairs Manager Susan Townsend, and Internal Affairs Investigator Melody Case. A CVSA examination was conducted. Corporal Devalle was asked to confirm the actions taken while performing kitchen duties on 5/25/25. The initial 005 and additional witness statement were collected which better explained course of action taken upon discovery and confirmation that Inmate Hardin was missing. The following relevant questions were interspersed with irrelevant and control questions.

Q.4. When asking about 1-D inmates, did FPM Captain Grady tell you "Business as Usual"?
(Meaning to conduct business as usual - which he interpreted as to continue with the work regularly performed)

The Subject responded "**Yes**" No Deception Indicated

Q.6. Did you know Inmate Hardin was planning an escape?
The Subject responded "**No**" No Deception Indicated

Q.10. did you help Inmate Hardin escape?
The subject responded "**NO**" No Deception Indicated

CONCLUSION: FACT Concurred

Based upon my training and experience, it is my opinion that the subject **did respond truthfully** to relevant questions. The Final Analysis Confirmation Tool was also used on the chart which [concurred] with my findings. IAD Manager Susan Townsend verified questions and responses and also concurred with finding of "**NDI**". FP/Kitchen Corporal – Justin Delvalle – **2nd Interview** / CVSA – NDI statement taken

Inmate Chad King ADC#660571: On 5/26/25 **3:53 AM** Inmate King explained he worked PM Kitchen staff, Pots and pans, emptied trash two times on 5/25/25 and that Inmate Hardin had come to him and told him to "**take over his chemical room duties while he went to go clean the chemical cage**". This was not Inmate King's normal duties, he explained he has filled in with the approval



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of Corporal Devalle as a substitute on occasion 4-5 times total; but that this is not his assigned duty. Inmate King says he was eating, and Inmate Hardin just took off. Inmate King went to the chemical room, and another inmate had asked if there were any scrubbing pads. Inmate King went to get Corporal Devalle, they went to find Inmate Hardin. They looked for Inmate Hardin, he could not find him. Inmate King stated that Corporal Devalle looked outside, and called him name, then went to laundry, and looked in the boiler room, and still did not find Inmate Hardin. He stated that Corporal Devalle appeared to be stunned and thought that the inmates were "playing with him, or that this was a drill, and called the barracks". After a few minutes, he realized that Inmate Hardin was truly missing and called laundry, and Sergeant Drinkard, (acting Lieutenant to confirmed that **"this was not a drill"**). Inmate King advised that Inmate Hardin was always "policing the inmates". He was not liked by any of the inmates, he was moody, unpredictable and was always running stairs in the barracks. Inmate Hardin was still in the building at 1:00 PM (kitchen count). Inmate Hardin went out about 2:00 PM to clean the chemical cage, and he was left in the chemical room inside the kitchen. Inmate King noted that he used to clean on the back dock with Inmate Morgan and Inmate Hardin. ***"Approximately 2-3 months ago, Inmate Hardin stopped going outside with the other inmates and would wait till they were finished with the dock work, then would go outside to clean alone"***.

CVSA Inmate Chad King:

On both May 26, 2025, IAD Thomas Rowland and I performed an ***initial incident interview*** to obtain information after the escape of inmate G. Hardin. A second interview was conducted on May 28, 2025, by IA Susan Townsend and I to in which information was confirmed and a CVSA was administered to confirm that Inmate King was not involved in aiding Inmate Hardin's escape. The following relevant questions were interspersed with irrelevant and control questions.

4. Did you have prior knowledge of Inmate Hardin planning an escape?

The Subject responded **"No"** No Deception Indicated

6. Did you help Inmate Hardin Escape?

The Subject responded **"No"** No Deception Indicated

CONCLUSION: FACT Concurred

Based upon my training and experience, it is my opinion that the subject **did respond truthfully** to relevant questions. The Final Analysis Confirmation Tool was also used on the chart which [concurred] with my findings. IA Manager Susan Townsend verified the CVSA responses and also concurred with a final **"NDI"**. (No Deception Indicated)

Inmate Chad King ADC#660451 -2nd Interview and CVSA - NDI



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FPS Captain Hayden Grady was interviewed by internal Affairs on May 25, 2025.

On May 25, 2025, staff noted during the interview Captain Grady advised his work schedule is Monday-Friday where he was working his new position in the Kitchen. Captain Grady stated he has been in his new position for approximately three weeks. Captain Grady stated he knew Hardin had worked in the kitchen a long time (approximately 6 years) and remembered having a conversation about the bleach compound ratio. Captain Grady stated, "Inmate Hardin was weird, talked in a high pitch voice and gave off a creepy vibe." Captain Grady stated he called to the unit on the 25th and advised FPM Devalle that he needed to correct his time. Captain Grady also stated he would call and speak to his girlfriend who worked in the front entry. Captain Grady stated if he had questions about his new job, he would call Captain Bently, read the post orders or call Connie Dean.

Investigator Case noted, "Captain Grady took off his vest and was swinging it in a circle during the interview. Investigator Case also noted Captain Grady was sweating stating "he was hot."

FPM Captain Hayden Grady was reinterviewed by Internal Affairs on May 28, 2025.

On May 28, 2025, IAD Susan Townsend and Investigator Melody Case conducted an interview with Captain Hayden Grady. During the interview, Captain Grady was asked to explain why he was acting agitated to which he stated, "he was [REDACTED]"

[REDACTED] During the interview Captain Grady was asked why he was on the phone all the time while at work and asked who he was talking to, instead of being vigilant watching Inmate activity in the kitchen. Captain Grady said he had a girlfriend named Erica Benavente and that she worked the front entrance. (Captain Grady stated he and Erica Benavente are in a relationship and that they do call each other all day long- "almost every hour.") Captain Grady was then asked several questions in reference to what was said to FPS Corporal Devalle over the phone. Captain Grady stated he and Devalle talked about putting in his time, they talked about getting 1-D inmates, but that they had not been assigned and that the Warden informed all staff not to have inmates on the back dock unsupervised. Captain Grady was asked if he told FPS Duvalle "business as usual" without explaining what was meant in reference to Devalle asking if he could send Hardin out on the back dock. Captain Grady admitted "Business as usual" is a phrase he used. IAD asked Captain Grady for clarification concerning what he meant by the phrase, "business as usual." Captain Grady stated all staff had already been informed no inmate should be on the back dock by the Warden and staff signed a form that they understood these directives, so when he said, "business as usual" he just assumed Devalle understood what they had been told. Investigator Case noted the Kitchen Supervisor Grady provided his first written statement, that directly conflicts to his second written statement.

Deputy Warden K. Bolden noted he had put out a directive a week or so prior to this event, with **some direct instruction to kitchen staff to correct behaviors of lax security in the kitchen.**



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Deputy Warden Bolden specifically mentions to staff, "Not allowing unaccompanied workers on the back dock without a security officer present".

(See training/security note was discussed, keeping all doors secured. He along with the kitchen workers all signed that they did read this directive and signed it – **see casefile**)

Inmate Jeremy Lowery ADC#180798:

On May 26, 2025, Inmate Lowery was interviewed by IAD Thomas Rowland and Investigator Melody Case in reference to gathering information concerning Inmate Hardin's escape. Inmate Lowery advised he lived in 3 barracks and was assigned to maintenance. Inmate Lowery stated the only time his tools were used by someone else was when Inmate Phillips and Captain Grady attempted to fix his door lock. Inmate Lowery was asked about his knowledge and interaction with Inmate Hardin to which he described Inmate Hardin as "jovial, and they were friends." Inmate Lowery was asked if he had been threatened or asked for the use of tools by Hardin, to which he denied. Inmate Lowery stated he spent a lot of time with Inmate Hardin but could not answer what any of their conversations were about. Inmate Lowery expressed that Inmate Hardin did not discuss any personal information about his life. Inmate Lowery was asked a series of questions concerning Inmate Hardin's personal life to which he said he did not know anything about Hardin's personal life. Inmate Lowery stated Inmate Hardin only discussed superficial topics such as the **"lack of food quality, and gossip"**. Inmate Lowery was not helpful in providing any information and stated, **"To my knowledge, in my mind I am not withholding, in my mind I am not"**. Inmate Lowery was asked to describe Inmate Hardin's behavior when he stated, "Inmate Hardin would complain and was moody." Inmate Lowery did state he would see Inmate Harding when he would pick up and drop off his tool cart which was about two times a day.

Inmate Gary Wayne Laine ADC#177870:

On May 26, 2025, Inmate Laine was asked to describe his interactions with Inmate Hardin. Inmate Laine stated working with Inmate Hardin was like walking on eggshells and then stated Inmate Hardin was moody. Inmate Laine was asked to explain a typical day when he worked. Inmate Laine stated he worked from 9:00 AM to 10:30 PM and that on Sunday Inmate Hardin would clean the chemical room. Inmate Laine stated Devalle is "laid back" with no supervisors usually on Sunday. Inmate Laine stated Hardin would watch TV by himself and complain about other inmates. Inmate Laine stated Hardin would curse and gripe but that he never witnessed Hardin be violent. Inmate Laine stated he heard a few phones call describing Hardin's family and that Hardin had a daughter but most of what he had heard was "hearsay." Inmate Laine stated the talk of inmates is that Hardin may harm someone and Laine stated he would help with the investigation in any way he could.



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Inmate Mason Grant ADC#148826:

On May 26, 2025, Inmate Grant was interviewed by IAD Thomas Rowland and Investigator Melody Case. Inmate Grant was asked if he had noticed anything out of the ordinary today, when the inmate advised IAD that Inmate Hardin seemed to be in a good mood. Inmate Grant is assigned to "pot and pan duty" and has to collect chemical several times day from Inmate Hardin. I did notice Inmate Hardin being in the chemical room in the AM today, and Inmate King in the chemical room in the afternoon. He was not sure of time, as inmates are not allowed to have watches in the kitchen. About 2:00 PM, he believed that Inmate Hardin went out to work in the chemical cage. Inmate Grant stated Inmate Hardin is moody, and not approachable, and that all he had heard was Hardin had an incident with an officer. He stated Inmate Hardin did brag that he was there for murder. Inmate Grant explained that Inmate Hardin was agitated with him, because Grant waited at the doorway to get chemicals for pots and pans which made Inmate Hardin have to stop eating his huge plate of spaghetti and give him soap. Inmate Grant said Hardin made some rude comments about being disturbed during his meal. Inmate Grant also stated he has observed Inmate Hardin working out by "running." Inmate Grant advised that he and his family were from this area, and no one would help hide this type of guy, everyone is afraid he will hurt another person.

Inmate Austin Bailey ADC#183270:

On May 26, 2025, IAD interviewed Inmate Austin Bailey #183270. During the interview Inmate Bailey stated he was the head cook. When asked about Inmate Hardin, Inmate Bailey stated Inmate Hardin has a short temper, he stays to himself, he runs and lifts 100-pound bags of beans in the kitchen. Inmate Bailey also advised that his tablet was stolen about two weeks ago. Inmate Bailey advised that he has observed Inmate Hardin get mad, and slam stuff.

Inmate John Marsh ADC#171791:

On May 26, 2025, IAD interviewed Inmate John Marsh #171791. Inmate Marsh stated he was assigned to laundry, he does some stenciling, and that he does know how to sew. He stated the thread needles, and the sewing machines are under constant lock/key. Inmate Marsh stated he receives \$600.00 a month from his family, and that he makes tags. Inmate Marsh stated the string he uses is white and all supplies are logged by Sergeant White. Inmate Marsh stated he has not been asked to help Inmate Hardin, nor would he and that he does not know anyone that would help Inmate Hardin because Hardin is not liked by any of the inmates.

Inmate Lonnie Bryant ADC#174194:

On May 26, 2025, IAD interviewed Inmate Lonnie Bryant #174194. Inmate Bryant advised that the string, machines, needles and trash is under constant security and that Inmate Hardin keeps records on what inmates get. Inmate Bryant stated all needles and supplies as well as anything to be sewn uses white thread, and the inmate noted it could be colored with a sharpie. Inmate Bryant stated he has not been asked to make any stencil for Inmate Hardin, and that the inmate has never asked for anything but boxers and shoes. Inmate Bryant was asked about Inmate Cox who is terminally ill and if the inmate would help Inmate Hardin. Inmate Bryant stated Inmate



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Cox would not help Inmate Hardin because he is ex-military. He had never been asked for any supplies by Inmate Hardin, he nor anyone else that he knows would help Inmate Hardin.

Inmate Tristian N. Tiarks ADC#175488

On May 26, 2025, IAD interviewed Inmate Tristan Tiarks #175488. Inmate Tiarks stated he had worked in the area making stencils (shirt size names). The inmate stated all the supplies are kept under security, and that he gets money from his family. Inmate Tiarks stated there is an inventory done on logs and count on the items is methodical. Inmate Tiarks stated he has not been asked to aid Inmate Hardin in any way.

Inmate Timothy Cox ADC#156894 :

On May 26, 2025, IAD interviewed Inmate Timothy Cox #156894. Inmate Cox is the laundry clerk and has seen Inmate Hardin in passing. Inmate Cox stated he does not sew often because of his failing health. garment factory at Cummins previously (years ago). He has seen Inmate Hardin in passing, he does not sew often due to his failing health, he jokes about knowing how to quilt, learned from his family. (He is terminally ill and does paperwork when he is able). He has not been contacted to help Inmate Hardin, the supplies are secured and under constant security at all times, he has no information nor been asked to help make any stencil such as what has been seen of altered items pictured on video footage.

Inmate Sebastian Brown ADC#156621 5/26/2025 On May 26, 2025, IAD interviewed Inmate **Sebastian Brown ADC#156621** (Laundry -folds clothes/issues chemicals in issuance in 3 barracks) He has not been housed with Inmate Hardin, he has learned to sew but does not sew on a regular basis. The strings, or scraps are placed in trash, and disposed of. He has not been approached by Inmate Hardin in any way.

Inmate David Koutsky ADC#161356- 5/26/25 – On May 26, 2025, IAD interviewed Inmate (This inmate issues boxes, and socks) This inmate has worked with Inmate Hardin a few years ago, he was housed together also a few years ago. He did observe Inmate Hardin work out in the barracks. He issues toilet paper and other items to inmates; everything is strictly logged. He only really asked for chemicals such as degreaser for his specific job. He does not have contact with him, he has not been asked to aid this inmate in any way to escape.

(May 28-29 2025 IA Manager Susan Townsend /Investigator Melody Case interviewed the following inmates):

Inmate Charles Declue ADC#186159 (4 Bks) had previously been assigned to 5 barracks : Inmate Declue had discussed and repeated what some other inmates had said, as well as things discussed on the news; He does not have any information related to any direct knowledge of or about Inmate Hardin, he was discussing what he had heard over the phone with a family member. (All hearsay from a third party).



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Inmate Mark Curl ADC#182027 (PALS inmate) This inmate is **only repeating hearsay**; "he wants to have a say in his opinion of what he heard another inmate say". He expressed wanting his own commentary to be considered. This inmate was asked directly if he personally knew Inmate Hardin, he stated "**No**", this inmate was also asked if he had ever been housed with Inmate Hardin, in which he also stated "**No**". Inmate Curl was **dismissed** back to the barracks. **NO KNOWLEDGE**

According to Investigator Collin Frierson and Investigator Dametria Rochelle, the developed information that **Corporal Alex Bentley** was the former Food Prep Manager and had stepped down 3 months ago on 02/01/2025. Inmate Hardin was present under his supervision until Cpl. Bentley stepped down.

On 05/27/2025 Corporal Alex Bentley was present at the NCU posted a checkpoint during the search for escaped Inmate Grant Hardin ADC# 168541. Corporal Bentley was called for an interview with IAD Investigators Collin Frierson and Dametria Rochelle. Corporal Bentley was read the Administrative Warning, he signed the form stating he understood. Corporal Bentley was questioned about his time as the Kitchen Captain/Food Prep Manager. He stated that "**he supervised Inmate Grant Hardin and had him assigned to handle the chemicals for the kitchen such as bleach, oven cleaner, razor products, and other items that would have come in the 55-gallon barrels**". He stated that "**he did allow inmate Hardin on the back dock as well as other inmates and often radioed the West Tower to inform them to assist in supervising the inmates**". Corporal Bentley reported that "**he would regularly inspect the back dock and did not observe anything out of the ordinary**". Corporal Bentley reported that "**he left the position earlier this year because he wanted a change of pace due to working in that position for the past 20 plus years**". Corporal Bentley was informed that he may be called in for a follow-up interview if needed, he stated "**he understood**".

Internal Affairs Manager, Susan Townsend advised Investigator Frierson and Investigator Rochelle of the information reported during a phone call of **Inmate Robert Cabral ADC# 120962**.

(At approximately 16:00-16:15 Investigators Frierson and Rochelle conducted an interview):

Inmate Michael Morgan ADC #137123. Inmate Morgan stated "**he worked in the Kitchen on the serving line and did not have to interact with inmate Hardin outside of requesting cleaning items from him, such as soap and pot cleaner. He stated he did not converse with him**".

Staff conducted an interview at approximately 16:25-16:42 with **Inmate Robert Cabral ADC #120962**: Inmate Cabral was interviewed regarding his email he sent to his daughter and his wife about the news he saw concerning Inmate Hardin escaping the unit. "He continued to state that he did not know inmate Hardin and had nothing to do with him". (CVSA Conducted by Investigator Case and Investigator/IA Manager Townsend) This inmate was Cleared by IA/NDI



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IAD interviewed Inmate Jeff Kendrick ADC #159535:

Inmate Kendrick reported that "he was also trained as back up for the chemical room for when Inmate Hardin was off. He stated that he did not have many dealings with Inmate Hardin and stated that he was weird and not very approachable". He stated that "he did not report observing anything suspicious on the back dock when he worked and stated he was supervised by staff".

Investigator Frierson and Investigator Rochell then conducted another interview at approximately 17:20-17:40 with Inmate Fredrick Knight ADC #185013. Inmate Knight reported that "he worked for Captain Bently and had changed his job assignment shortly after he left". Inmate Knight reported that "he was a backup worker for the chemical room and was trained by Inmate Hardin". He stated "he did not observe anything out of the ordinary when working on the back dock area". Inmate Knight also reported that "he was under to supervision of FPS Delvalle and noted that he took his attention off of the inmates in the kitchen to talk to other staff in the unit".

At approximately 19:15-19:25 Investigator Collin Frierson sat in on an interview with an Arkansas State Police Agents to question Inmate Delbert Wilson ADC #105529. Inmate Wilson was questioned regarding the email he sent to his significant other. Inmate Wilson stated that "he just repeated what he overheard from an officer during pill call". He stated that "he stays on the North Wing of the Unit and would not have seen anything with Inmate Hardin's escape". Inmate Wilson also stated that "there was another inmate in the facility named Grant Hardin who is a black male and thought it was him who had escaped".

05/31/2021

Inmate Aaron Duncan ADC 166488

Interview was conducted with inmate Aaron Duncan regarding his relationship with inmate Hardin. Inmate Duncan stated that he used his mother to receive a care package one time. In a phone conversation between inmate Duncan and his mother, Donna Duncan, she mentioned that she messaged inmate Hardin. Inmate Duncan stated that he was not involved with inmate Hardin and consented to a CVSA exam. CVSA exam results NDI. Later the same day, inmate Duncan was brought back to be interviewed and conducted a second CVSA exam.

#4. Did inmate Hardin discuss any escape plans with you? No Deception Indicated

#6. Have you lied about anything in your statements? No Deception Indicated

On 05/31/2025 Inmates Charles Hornbeck ADC#178852, Christopher Powell ADC 179523, Bobby Anderson ADC 143312, Allen West ADC 166046, Jeff Batson ADC 131171, Victor Wilmoth ADC 168042, and Richard Hahn ADC 106317.



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On 05/31/2025 A "kite was received from an anonymous inmate who reported that chapel porter inmates Hornbeck and Powell had supplied ink pens/ markers to inmate Hardin".

Inmate Christopher Powell ADC#179523: Inmate Powell reported the same as Inmate Hornbeck, stating that he does not know Inmate Hardin and has not seen him at any church services. Inmate Powell denied giving any ink pens or markers to inmate Hardin and consented to a CVSA examination to confirm his statement. CVSA examination:

Q.4. Did you give inmate Hardin any ink pens?	No	No	Deception Indicated
Q.6. Did you give inmate Hardin any sharpie markers?	No	No	Deception Indicated

Inmate Powell then reported that two other inmates had been fired as Chaplin porters and they were also in the barracks with inmate Hardin. Inmate Powell gave the names of inmates Allen West and Victor Wilmoth.

Inmate Alan West ADC#166046: Inmate West stated that he was a Chaplin Porter months ago but was let go by the Chaplin. Inmate West denied giving any ink pens or markers to inmate Hardin. Inmate West consented to a CVSA examination:

Q.4. Did you give ink pens to inmate Hardin?	No	No	Deception Indicated
Q.6. Did you give sharpie markers to inmate Hardin?	No	No	Deception Indicated
Q.10. Did inmate Hardin discuss any escape plans with you?	No	No	Deception Indicated

Inmate Victor Wilmoth ADC#168042: Inmate Wilmoth reported the same as inmate Alan West. He stated that he was a chapel porter at one time but was let go by the Chaplin. Inmate Wilmoth denied giving ink pens or markers to inmate Hardin. Inmate Wilmoth consented to a CVSA examination:

Q.4. Did you give ink pens to inmate Hardin?	No	No	Deception Indicated
Q.6. Did you give inmate Hardin sharpie markers?	No	No	Deception Indicated
Q.10. Did inmate Hardin discuss his escape plan with you?	No	No	Deception Indicated

Inmates Jeff Batson ADC#131171: was interviewed. He reported that he worked on the garden crew and did not know inmate Hardin. Inmate Batson was returned back to his barracks.



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Inmate Bobby Anderson ADC#143312: He reported that he worked in the kitchen bakery and had access to the dry storage. He was asked if he gave any food items to inmate Hardin. He stated yes, he gave him a spoon of peanut butter at the end of his shift when he asked for it. Inmate Anderson stated he did not give inmate Hardin any jars or containers of peanut butter to take out of the kitchen. Inmate Anderson was then returned back to his barracks.

Inmate Richard Hahn ADC#106317: He had written a letter to his stepmother stating that he had spoken with Inmate Hardin before his escape. The letter was intercepted by mail room staff. Inmate Hahn was brought to Investigators Rochelle and I for interview. Inmate Hahn reported that he wrote the letter to let his family know that he knew inmate Hardin and has spoken to him. Inmate Hahn stated that he and Hardin would talk about his police days when he was in the barracks and that Hardin didn't want anyone to know he was cop or a sex offender, so he only spoke to him. Inmate Hahn consented to a CVSA examination:

Q.4. Did inmate Hard discuss his prior police experiences with you? **Yes No Deception Indicated**

Q.6. Did inmate Hardin discuss any escape plans with you? **No Deception Indicated**

The following inmates and staff were interviewed by (Investigator Derwin Metcalf/IAD Administrator Thomas Rowland (AM) June 2, 2025 through (AM) June 3, 2025)

Inmate Hornbeck, Charles #178802 interviewed at 12:00 noon by Investigator Metcalf and IA Administrator Thomas Rowland. Inmate Hornbeck was being held in restricted Housing ADC under suspension. Inmate Hornbeck stated that he had heard that inmates Wilmoth, Victor ADC# 16802, Allen West ADC #166046 were rumored to have assisted inmate Hardin by supplying him with markers to dye his clothing. (*recommended for transfer to another facility*).

Inmate Curl Mark ADC# 182027, interviewed at 12:23 pm by investigator Metcalf and Administrator Rowland submitted a letter written to allege rumors being spread by other inmates. Allegations unsubstantiated. (*recommend for transfer to another facility*)

Inmate Declue, Charles #186159 interviewed at 12:45 pm by Investigator Metcalf and Administrator Rowland denied any knowledge of escape after being identified of making a call to a relative talking about escape. (*recommend transfer to another facility*)

Inmate Duncan, Aaron ADC# 166488 interviewed at 1:10pm by Investigator Metcalf and Administrator Rowland confirmed that he had his mother place money on inmate Hardin's books for a holiday package. Inmate Duncan was also found deceptive on a CVSA examination given at

Inmate Powell, Christopher ADC# 179523 interviewed at 1:30 pm by Investigator Metcalf and Administrator Rowland, inmate denied any knowledge of the escape of inmate Hardin after making a call talking about the escape of inmate Hardin. (*recommend transfer to another facility*)



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Inmate Clingmon, Jeremy ADC# 154279, interviewed at 1:45pm by Investigator Metcalf and Administrator Rowland gave information about a staff member (FPS B. Catlett) who was terminated for employee misconduct in an incident involving inmate Clingmon. He also stated that inmate Joseph Cox ADC# 655318 could verify and may have knowledge of a conversation about inmate Hardin prior to the escape.

Inmate Cox, Joseph ADC# 655318 was interviewed at 2:20 pm by Investigator Metcalf and Administrator Rowland and verified the information concerning FPS Catlett but denied any knowledge of hearing about inmate Hardin's escape.

Inmate Love, Steven ADC# 182113, was interviewed at 3:08 pm by investigator Metcalf and Administrator Rowland. Inmate love submitted a witness statement attesting that inmate Mehn, Joshua ADC 176832 told him that he saw inmate Hardin make multiple trips to the laundry the day of his escape and saw him walking down the hall with a pair of boots and mop heads.

Cpl. Andrew Teegarden was interviewed at 4:45 am 6/3/2025. Cpl. Teegarden worked as the laundry supervisor. Cpl. Teegarden said that Cpl. Walker Called him from the West Tower asking if he knew who the person was that was out at sally port wearing a vest, ball cap and glasses, Cpl. Teegarden stated that he advised him that he did not know and noticed a short time later traffic over the radio and shift Sgt's proceeding to the sally port looking around searching the area. Cpl. Teegarden stated that he often let his porter out of the backdoor to place the trash out, but he walks them to the door and watches them till they come back in.

Inmate Stephen Love ADC# 182113 was interviewed on 6/3/2025, at approximately 6:35 am, concerning the witness statement he submitted stating that inmate Mehn ADC# 176832 had told him he had seen inmate Hardin making trips to the laundry and taking supplies down the hall. Inmate Love confirmed his statement.

Inmate Joshua Mehn ADC# 176832 was then brought to speak with Internal Affairs at approximately 6:45 am on 6/3/2025 and advised of the statement against him inmate Mehn denied the allegation, stating he had said nothing about inmate Hardin.

Inmate S. Love: He was brought back to speak with Investigator Metcalf and Administrator Rowland and was given a CVSA examination. Inmate love was asked two relevant questions:

4.) Did inmate Mehn tell you he saw inmate Hardin getting boots from the laundry?

Yes No deception indicated.

6.) Did inmate Mehn tell you that he saw inmate Hardin carrying mop heads down the hall?

Yes No deception indicated.



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Inmate Mehn: He was brought back to speak with Mr. Metcalf and Mr. Rowland. He was given a CVSA examination and asked two relevant questions. **Inmate Mehn's was found to be deceptive on his CVSA investigation and placed in restrictive housing**

Sergeant Drinkard: He was interviewed concerning a statement made by Corporal W. Walker that he contacted him in the tower while he was tracking inmate Hardin out of the gate. **Sergeant Drinkard stated that he did not call Cpl. Walker about anything.** He stated that Cpl. Walker called him, stating that he had seen a COI walking across the road and had got out of sight. He reported to the back dock and searched for inmate Harding whom he was advised by the Kitchen Supervisor to be missing. He was advised by Corporal Walker, the unknown person, had walked behind the ICC garage. Sergeant Drinkard stated that he went back into the building and began an emergency count and escape protocols.

The following Inmates were interviewed on June 3, 2025, by Investigator Derwin Metcalf, Investigator Susan Townsend and IAD Administrator Thomas Rowland due a confidential informant providing information to local law enforcement concerning Inmate Hardin and his possible use of a cell phone along with someone who may have knowledge of who gave Inmate Hardin black Ink. The following inmates were interviewed to see if they had any knowledge of the inmate's Escape or helped him in any way. A search was conducted with no phone being recovered.

Inmate Sifuentes, Antonio ADC#173376 stated he worked in the ICC Garage and did not know Inmate Hardin. Inmate Sifuentes stated he did not work on the day the inmate escaped and was not housed with Inmate Hardin. Sifuentes stated when they go out on Friday they are allowed in the sallyport office so they can see the list showing where everyone will work on the weekend. Inmate Sifuentes stated he did not know there was a hundred-dollar bill or a fake 100-dollar bill in a calendar when asked. **Investigator Note** – staff later admitted they had put the 100-dollar fake bill in the calendar for kicks and giggles. Records incident this inmate was not housed with Inmate Hardin.

Inmate Everett, James ADC#109614 stated he had tattoos and was known for giving tattoos. Inmate Everett stated he knew Inmate Hardin, but voiced Inmate Hardin did not like him because he had tattoos and gave tattoos. Inmate Everett stated an inmate named Corline, Justin who had just gotten locked up for making tattoo ink is the one who made it for him. When asked if he knew if that inmate would sell or give anyone else in the barracks ink he said no, it takes too long to make a small 0.5 amount of ink, and the inmate would only make it for him. Inmate Everett explained the best way to make in was to burn the plastic from the disposable razors. Inmate Everett stated he just got busted for having a tattoo motor in December which records support. Inmate Everett stated Hardin would only talk to him when Hardin wanted to talk about the Old



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Testament and that Hardin did not like him, so it was more like he was preaching at him. Inmate Everett said Hardin did not like to talk about the New Testament or Jesus.

Investigator Note: (Investigator S. Townsend was unable to locate Inmate Corline. After a thorough search of eOMIS Investigator Townsend was able to determine on 6/6/2025 the inmate who made ink for Inmate Everett was Inmate Justin Carnline ADC#180364).

The following inmates and staff were interviewed by (Investigator Susan Townsend IAD Manager June 3, 2025

Inmate Dallas Larson 154472: He was very detail oriented and gave detailed description of the area and his job duties. Inmate Larson explained staff was outside when they were sent to work and then told what equipment was handed out by him. The inmate explained details of handing out water jugs to mowers to give out tools for field. Inmate Larson was asked if he knew inmate Hardin and he said no. Inmate Larson said if he knew anything he would tell us and did not know if there was anyone at ICC garage that would help Inmate Hardin or knew Inmate Hardin.

Inmate Turner Joshua ADC#179988: He only knew Inmate Everett stating that inmate was his friend and helped him do his job when he did not know what to do. Inmate Turner was hard of hearing and had trouble vocalizing his thoughts. Inmate Turner said he did not know Inmate Donald Harris or Inmate Hardin. Inmate Turner said he walked a lot in the barracks for his job.

Inmate Donald Harris 181498: He worked at ICC garage just got out there May 1st and started the second week of May. Inmate Harris stated he lived in Missouri, one hour from Saint Louis. Tool shed, hands tools to inmates, tool clerk, hand them tools, mow change oil around the shop. Gray Conex beside the garage. Turn out go to shop check in – whoever is in charge unlock mower shed and Conex – staff - is there supervision 1B - they can see us from their office but if no one was looking out the window they could not see us. Inmate said they would see the list from the sally port office on Friday to see where they would be working the weekend. Inmate Harris said he is not friends and does not like Inmate Hardin. Inmate Harris said he has nothing to do with Hardin and it was because of the inmate's charge. (sex offender)

Inmate Christopher Conduff ADC#184315: Just got assigned out to the ICC garage in the past two weeks. Inmate Conduff was in 12 barracks. Did you know Inmate Harden and he said the inmate worked in the kitchen, but he had nothing to do with Hardin. Inmate Conduff was not housed with Inmate Hardin and Conduff stated he only worked in there during the holidays. Inmate Conduff stated he has worked on the cars, trucks, motors, Pine Bluff vehicles, brakes, water pump, expeditions, for the past two weeks.

On 5-25-2025 Inmate Hardin, Grant ADC#168541 escaped from the unit using a makeshift officer's uniform. He was assigned as the Kitchen Chemical Clerk and gained access to the Kitchen back dock area unsupervised. Inmate Harden was allowed to exit the Sallyport gate area unchallenged by the West Tower Security Staff on post wearing makeshift officer's uniform. ADC staff and additional law enforcement conducted extensive searches for Inmate Hardin in the surrounding area. On 6-6-2025 Inmate Harden was apprehended by US Border Patrol staff approx. 1-5 miles northwest of the NCU in a wooded area. Inmate Harden was transported back to the NCU Unit and was seen by medical staff. His identity was verified by ASP staff using a portable fingerprint scanner. Inmate Hardin was then transferred to Varner Supermax pending disciplinary action for escape. Additional documentation will be submitted once reviewed.



STATEMENT: On May-28-25 at approx 230pm I cpl William Walker was Given a chance to add in the following Details to my Statement after sometime to calm Down and relax. It was at approx 300pm I got a phone call from Sgt K. Driskard letting me know that I had a Shooting Day on June 5th at the time of the phone call I had let the person dressed in what looked like ADC Uniform Thru the 2nd gate. While answering the phone I took my eyes off the person and lost sight of him

On 5/25/25 at approximately 3:15 PM I, Captain Chris Brandon, was in the main hallway supervising the evening chow call. At this time, Sgt. Kendall Drinkard received a phone call, in my immediate vicinity, on the hallway phone (phone #3350) from Cpl. William Walker who was assigned to West Tower (phone #3316). Cpl. Walker reported that he had opened the walkthrough gates at sallyport and let an "officer" pushing a cart out but he did not know where he went. He explained that he was on the catwalk and watched him push the cart to the ICC Garage when the telephone rang. He answered the telephone but there was no one on the phone and when he returned to the catwalk the "officer" was gone. As soon as Sgt. Drinkard hung up the phone, he received a second phone call from FPS Justin Delvalle (phone #3321) reporting that Inmate Hardin, Grant ADC# 168541, was on the back dock of the kitchen cleaning and he was unable to locate him. I instructed Sgt. Drinkard, Sgt. Justin Balentine, and Sgt. Gary Queen to search the back dock and sallyport area. Sgt. Drinkard reported back to me that they were unable to locate Inmate Hardin. At approximately 3:24 PM I radioed Master Control to stop all inmate movement placing the unit on lockdown status then notified Warden Thomas Hurst. The unit was advised to standby for emergency roster count, the rosters were printed and distributed; the emergency roster count began at 3:47 PM and completed at 4:58 PM with all barracks clear except for barrack 05 rack 05 assigned to Inmate Hardin and confirming that Inmate Hardin was not accounted for. I proceeded to Master Control where I watched the Avigilon perimeter cameras in the presence of Sgt. Jeff Cooper. At approximately 3:40 PM, by viewing the camera of sallyport, Sgt. Cooper and I confirmed that Inmate Hardin had escaped from the North Central Unit wearing black clothing, a black hat, and what appeared to be a security vest with white lettering on the front and back. He was pushing a flat silver cart with 2 wooden pallets on it and a cardboard box. I immediately reported this to Warden Hurst who instructed me to open the Command Center and conduct an emergency roster count. The emergency manual was opened to the "Escape" section and notifications were initiated.


