STATE BOARD OF EMBALMERS, FUNERAL DIRECTORS, CEMETERIES, AND BURIAL SERVICES Act 595 Monthly Status Report

The following Acts from the 2023 legislative session require rulemaking and were <u>not</u> included in the *Report on the Acts of the 2023 Regular Session Requiring New Rulemaking*. However, the Board of Embalmers, Funeral Directors, Cemeteries, and Burial Services believes rulemaking is needed for the operation of the laws and will be taking the following rulemaking actions for these Acts:
