Act 595 Monthly Status Report

The following Acts from the 2023 legislative session require rulemaking and were not included in the *Report on the Acts of the 2023 Regular Session Requiring New Rulemaking*. However, the Board of Embalmers, Funeral Directors, Cemeteries, and Burial Services believes rulemaking is needed for the operation of the laws and will be taking the following rulemaking actions for these Acts:

Act 368	Rule Pertaining to Embalmers, Funeral Directors, Funeral Establishments, Crematories, Crematory Retort Operators, and Transport Services	1	Act 368 of 2023 revises the due date for renewal of licenses for embalmers and funeral directors. Status: Waiting to be placed on the ALC-Administrative Rules agenda for approval.	Amend Rule
