335	Minimum Dementia Training Requirements pursuant to Act 335 of 2023	Act 335 amends Arkansas Code §20-10-2401 to require minimum dementia training for staff members who are employed by an assisted living facility to address gaps in current dementia training requirements. 703	Rules for Life Choices Lifeline and Continuum of Care Programs	Act 703 of 2023 transfers responsibility for administering the Life Choices Lifeline from the Department of Health to Arkansas Department of Human Services (DHS). 806	Residential Licensing Standards	This Act provides state oversight of quality of care provided to children in psychiatric residential treatment facilities and other regulated facilities.
