 - 3. an inmate assault on an employee;
 - use of force by an employee on an inmate;
 - an inmate suicide attempt;
 - escapes or unauthorized absences;
 - 7. inmate or employee deaths;
 - 8. major property loss or damage;
 - 9. the personal knowledge of inmate or staff giving false information;
 - 10. a violation of any Department Division policy;
 - 11. any inmate or employee actions which could lead to criminal charges.

All other reports of a serious nature, as so determined by the Unit Warden/Center Supervisor/Administrator, shall also be forwarded to the Deputy Director and incident notification list.

D. The Director shall issue an Administrative Directive to ensure that all notifications are made and recorded appropriately.
