

Section 1.33 (16) Posting of Pregnancy Warning. The warning shall be printed in English and Spanish.



SUMMARY OF SUBSTANTIVE CHANGES

1.33 (16) is a new Rule. Act 860 of 2019 requires all alcohol permittees to post an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 inch pregnancy warning.

29	requirements under § 3-9-102.
