## Thoroughbred Rule 1217D(5) Amendment Summary

This amendment prohibits the use of Clenbuterol or any other beta-2 agonist within sixty (60) days of a race.

## Thoroughbred Rule 1217D(5) Mark Up

(5) The use of clenbuterol in thoroughbreds shall be permitted under the following conditions: Not to exceed one hundred forty (140) picograms per milliliter clenbuterol in urine or the limit of detection (LOD) in serum or plasmaadministration of clenbuterol or any other beta-2 agonist to a horse within the sixty (60) day period immediately preceding a race in which the horse participates at Oaklawn is prohibited. The presence of clenbuterol shall not exceed the limit of detection (LOD) in or any other beta-2 agonist in a horse's urine, serum, plasma, or hair at a level of detection indicating use within said sixty (60) day period shall be a violation of this rule.
