Re: Request to Exclude Act 594 from Act 595 Status Report

Dear Senator Hammer and Representative Eaves:

Act 594 of 2021 created the Logging and Wood Fiber Transportation Job Creation Incentive Act, which provides for a new tax credit on qualified equipment purchases related to qualified wood energy product and forest maintenance projects.

The Arkansas Economic Development Commission respectfully requests that Act 594 be excluded from AEDC's reporting obligations to the Administrative Rules Subcommittee under Act 595 of 2021. AEDC has determined that a rule is not required for Act 594 in that the act does not explicitly confer rulemaking authority on AEDC, and the text of the act is sufficiently specific to enable AEDC to administer the tax credit program. A rule would merely restate the text of the law, resulting in unnecessary rule promulgation.
