RULE D-13: USE OF GAS FOR OTHER THAN LIGHT OR FUEL

Before any person shall engage in the utilization of gas for purposes other than light and fuel he shall file with the Commission a verified statement setting for the name and addresses of the person or persons who are to engage in the proposed operations, the location of the plant of plants where the proposed utilization is to be carried on, the kind and probable volume of the gas that is to be used, the reservoir from which it is to be taken, the general type of the process, and the kind and condition of the equipment that is to be used, the results to be obtained in so far as such results can be reasonably anticipated, and such other pertinent facts as the Commission may require. Upon filing said statement the Commission may, if it deems the same necessary, conduct a public hearing with reference to the proposed utilization in order to determine whether such utilization or the use of the proposed processes and equipment will constitute waste.
