

Rule 2099.1(4) Amendment Summary

This Amendment of Rule 2099.1(4) adds a new paragraph numbered (4) with requirements for a horse which has not started a race for periods of six months or one year.

Rule 2099.1(4) Mark Up

2099.1(4). A horse which has not started for a period of six (6) months or more prior to a race day must have three officially published timed workouts, two of which must be within 30 days of the race and one of which must be at a distance of four (4) furlongs or more. A horse which has not started for a period of one (1) year or more must also undergo a physical examination by a regulatory veterinarian and be approved in writing by the regulatory veterinarian prior to being entered in a race. The workouts must have occurred at a pari-mutuel horse racing facility or a recognized horse training facility, approved by the Stewards.

The current paragraph numbered 2099.1(4) will be renumbered to 2099.1(5), and the current paragraph numbered 2099.1(5) will be renumbered to 2099.1(6).
