

Rule 2110(a) Amendment Summary

This Amendment of Rule 2110(a) will increase license fees for owners, stable names, trainers, assistant trainers, jockeys, apprentice jockeys and jockey agents per the recent amendment to Arkansas law contained in Ark. Code Ann. § 23-110-204, which authorizes license fees of up to \$150. The Commission will consider two proposals, one a \$30 increase and the second a \$45 increase.

Rule 2110(a) Mark Up

2110. (a) The following persons shall secure a license from the Commission and the annual fee shall be as follows:
