Rule 2371 Amendment Summary

This Amendment of Rule 2371 clarifies the Stewards' discretion when determining whether to

disqualify a horse running as a coupled entry, when there is a foul in the race.

Rule 2371 Mark Up

2371. If a horse be is disqualified for a foul under these Rules, any other horse in the race owned wholly or in part by the same interest or trained by the same trainer may also be disqualified if the Stewards determine the second part of the coupled or uncoupled entry benefitted from the actions of the disqualified stablemate.
