### For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT A VOTER PROVIDE VERIFICATION  
OF VOTER REGISTRATION WHEN VOTING; TO AMEND AMENDMENT  
51 OF THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO REQUIRE THAT A VOTER PROVIDE  
VERIFICATION OF VOTER REGISTRATION WHEN  
VOTING; AND TO AMEND AMENDMENT 51 OF THE  
ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

*SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 6(a)(2), concerning  
statements included on the mail voter registration application form, is  
amended to read as follows:*

*(2) Such forms shall include, in identical print, statements  
that:*

- (A) Specify voter eligibility requirements;*
- (B) Contain an attestation that the applicant meets all  
voter eligibility requirements and that the applicant does not claim the  
right to vote in another county or state;*
- (C) Specify the penalties provided by law for submission*



1 of a false voter registration application;

2 (D) Inform applicants that where they register to vote  
3 will be kept confidential; ~~and~~

4 (E) Inform applicants that declining to register will also  
5 be kept confidential; ~~and~~

6 (F) Inform applicants that they will be required to verify  
7 their registration when voting in person or by absentee ballot by providing a  
8 required document or identification card as provided in Arkansas  
9 Constitution, Amendment 51, § 13.

11 SECTION 2. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 13 is amended to  
12 read as follows:

13 § 13. Fail-safe voting – Verification of voter registration.

14 (a) If a voter presents himself or herself at a polling place on the  
15 date of an election but no record of his or her voter registration can be  
16 located by the judges of the election on the precinct voter registration  
17 list, ~~such~~ the voter shall be permitted to vote only under the conditions set  
18 forth in § 7-5-306 or § 7-7-308.

19 (b)(1)(A) In order to determine that all who cast a ballot in an  
20 election, a runoff election, or a school election in this state are legally  
21 qualified to vote in that election, each voter shall verify his or her  
22 registration by:

23 (i) Presenting to the election official when  
24 appearing to vote in person either early or at the polls on election day in  
25 an election, a runoff election, or a school election verification of  
26 registration in the form of a document or identification card that:

27 (a) Shows the name of the person to whom the  
28 document or identification card was issued;

29 (b) Shows a photograph of the person to whom  
30 the document or identification card was issued;

31 (c) Is issued by the United States, the State  
32 of Arkansas, or an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the  
33 State of Arkansas; and

34 (d) If displaying an expiration date, is not  
35 expired or expired no more than four (4) years before the date of the  
36 election in which the voter seeks to vote; or

1 (ii) Submitting with an absentee ballot in an  
2 election, a runoff election, or a school election a copy of a document or  
3 identification card that complies with the requirements of subdivision  
4 (b)(1)(A)(i) of this section.

5 (B) Documents and identification cards that comply with  
6 the requirements of subdivision (b)(1)(A) of this section include without  
7 limitation:

8 (i) A driver's license;

9 (ii) A photo identification card;

10 (iii) A concealed handgun carry license;

11 (iv) A United States passport;

12 (v) An employee badge or identification document  
13 issued by an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the State of  
14 Arkansas;

15 (vi) A United States military identification  
16 document;

17 (vii) A public assistance identification card if the  
18 card shows a photograph of the person to whom the document or identification  
19 card was issued; and

20 (viii) A voter verification card under § 7-5-324.

21 (2)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(2)(B) of this  
22 section, if a voter is unable to verify his or her registration when voting  
23 in person by presenting a document or identification card that complies with  
24 subdivision (b)(1)(A)(i) of this section, the election official shall:

25 (i) Indicate on the precinct voter registration list  
26 that the voter did not present a required document or identification card;  
27 and

28 (ii) Permit the voter to cast a provisional ballot  
29 and inform the voter of the requirements under subdivision (b)(4) of this  
30 section.

31 (B)(i) A person who is a resident of a long-term care or  
32 residential care facility licensed by the state of Arkansas is not required  
33 to verify his or her registration by presenting a document or identification  
34 card that complies with subdivision (b)(1)(A)(i) of this section when voting  
35 in person.

36 (ii) A person not required to present a document or

1 identification card under subdivision (b)(2)(B)(i) of this section shall  
2 provide documentation from the administrator of the facility attesting that  
3 the person is a resident of the facility.

4 (3)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(3)(B) of this  
5 section, if a voter voting by absentee ballot fails to submit with the ballot  
6 documentation that complies with subdivision (b)(1)(A)(ii) of this section,  
7 the absentee ballot shall be considered a provisional ballot.

8 (B) The following persons shall not be required to submit  
9 with his or her absentee ballot documentation that complies with subdivision  
10 (b)(1)(A)(ii) of this section:

11 (i) An active duty member of the uniformed services  
12 of the United States or United States Merchant Marine who is absent from the  
13 country on election day because of his or her service;

14 (ii) The spouse or dependant of an active duty  
15 member of the uniformed services of the United States or United States  
16 Merchant Marine under subdivision (b)(3)(B)(i) of this section who is absent  
17 from the country on election day because of the service of the member; or

18 (iii)(a) A resident of a long-term care or  
19 residential care facility licensed by the state of Arkansas.

20 (b) A person not required to submit a document  
21 or identification card under subdivision (b)(3)(B)(iii)(a) of this section  
22 shall provide documentation from the administrator of the facility attesting  
23 that the person is a resident of the facility.

24 (4) A provisional ballot cast by a voter who did not present a  
25 required document or identification card shall be counted if:

26 (A)(i)(a) The voter completes a sworn statement at the  
27 polling site when voting either early or at the polls on election day stating  
28 that the voter is registered to vote in this state and that he or she is the  
29 person registered to vote.

30 (b) A sworn statement completed under  
31 subdivision (b)(4)(A)(i)(a) of this section is not required to be notarized  
32 but the voter shall execute the sworn statement under penalty of perjury.

33 (c) A sworn statement completed at the polling  
34 site shall be delivered to the county board of election commissioners so that  
35 the provisional ballot may be counted; and

36 (ii) The county board of election commissioners does

1 not determine that the provisional ballot is invalid and should not be  
2 counted based on other grounds; or

3 (B)(i) The voter returns to the county board of election  
4 commissioners or the county clerk by 12:00 noon on the Monday following the  
5 election and presents a document or identification card that complies with  
6 the requirements of subdivision (b)(1)(A)(i) of this section; and

7 (ii) The county board of election commissioners does  
8 not determine that the provisional ballot is invalid and should not be  
9 counted based on other grounds.

10 (5) A provisional ballot cast by an absentee voter who failed to  
11 submit with an absentee ballot documentation that complies with subdivision  
12 (b)(1)(A)(ii) of this section shall be counted if:

13 (A)(i)(a) The voter completes and returns the sworn  
14 statement portion of the absentee ballot form stating that the voter is  
15 registered to vote in this state and that he or she is the person registered  
16 to vote.

17 (b) A sworn statement returned under  
18 subdivision (b)(5)(A)(i)(a) of this section is not required to be notarized  
19 but the voter shall execute the sworn statement under penalty of perjury; and

20 (ii) The county board of election commissioners does  
21 not determine that the provisional ballot is invalid and should not be  
22 counted based on other grounds; or

23 (B)(i) The voter returns to the county board of election  
24 commissioners or the county clerk by 12:00 noon on the Monday following the  
25 election and presents a copy of a document or identification card that  
26 complies with the requirements of subdivision (b)(1)(A)(i) of this section;  
27 and

28 (ii) The county board of election commissioners does  
29 not determine that the provisional ballot is invalid and should not be  
30 counted based on other grounds.

31 (6) A person registering to vote by mail and who has not  
32 previously voted in a federal election in this state shall only be required  
33 to comply with § 7-5-201(e).

34 (7) The State Board of Election Commissioners shall promulgate  
35 rules necessary to implement subsection (b) of this section, including  
36 without limitation the preparation of a sworn statement to be used by voters

1 who cast a provisional ballot under subsection (b) of this section.

2 (8)(A) Following each election, the county board of election  
 3 commissioners may review the precinct voter registration lists and may  
 4 provide the information of each voter not presenting a document or  
 5 identification card necessary to verify his or her voter registration when  
 6 voting in person or by absentee ballot to the prosecuting attorney.

7 (B) The county board of election commissioners shall refer  
 8 suspected instances of voter fraud to the prosecuting attorney.

9 (C) The prosecuting attorney may investigate possible  
 10 voter fraud.

11 (D) Upon application based upon affidavits of one (1) or  
 12 more qualified voters by the appropriate prosecuting attorney alleging  
 13 possible voter fraud, the appropriate circuit judge, for good cause shown,  
 14 may order the permanent registrar to cancel the registration of the voter  
 15 failing to verify his or her registration as provided by this subsection.

16  
 17 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 14, Subchapter 1, is amended  
 18 to add an additional section to read as follows:

19 6-14-123. Verification of voter registration.

20 (a) A voter in a school election voting either in person or by  
 21 absentee ballot shall comply with Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, § 13,  
 22 concerning verification of voter registration to the extent it is applicable  
 23 to the voter.

24 (b) If a ballot or absentee ballot is deemed a provisional ballot for  
 25 failure to provide verification of registration under Arkansas Constitution,  
 26 Amendment 51, § 13, the voter shall comply with the procedures under Arkansas  
 27 Constitution, Amendment 51, § 13, for his or her vote to be counted.

28  
 29 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-1-101(31)-(38), concerning definitions  
 30 applicable to Title 7 of the Arkansas Code, are amended to read as follows:

(B) Counted contingent upon the verification of the voter's eligibility;

~~(33)(32)~~ "Qualified elector" means a person who holds the qualifications of an elector and who is registered pursuant to Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51;

~~(34)(33)~~ "Sample ballot" means a ballot for distribution to the public or the press marked with the word "SAMPLE" so as to prevent the production of counterfeit ballots;

~~(35)(34)~~ "Uniformed services" means the United States Army, United States Navy, United States Air Force, United States Marine Corps, United States Coast Guard, the United States Public Health Service

1 Commissioned Corps, and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration  
2 Commissioned Officer Corps, or as defined in the federal Uniformed and

30 (i) Presenting a document or identification card  
31 when appearing to vote in person that:

32 (a) Shows the name of the person to whom the  
33 document or identification card was issued;

34 (b) Shows a photograph of the person to whom  
35 the document or identification card was issued;

36 (c) Is issued by the United States, the State



1 of Arkansas, or an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the  
2 State of Arkansas; and

3 (d) If displaying an expiration date, is not  
4 expired or expired no more than four (4) years before the date of the  
5 election in which the voter seeks to vote; or

6 (ii) Submitting with an absentee ballot verification  
7 of voter registration in the form of a copy of a document or identification  
8 card that complies with the requirements of subdivision (38)(A)(i) of this

10 (B) Documents and identification cards that comply with  
11 the requirements of subdivision (38)(A) of this section include without  
12 limitation:

13 (i) A driver's license;

14 (ii) A photo identification card;

15 (iii) A concealed handgun carry license;

16 (iv) A United States passport;

17 (v) An employee badge or identification document  
18 issued by an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the State of  
19 Arkansas;

20 (vi) A United States military identification  
21 document;

22 (vii) A public assistance identification card if the  
23 card shows a photograph of the person to whom the document or identification  
24 card was issued; and

25 (viii) A voter verification card under § 7-5-324;

27 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 7-5-201(d) and (e), concerning voter  
28 qualification, are amended to read as follows:

29 (d)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (d)(2) of this section and  
30 subsection (e) of this section, any person desiring to vote in this state  
31 shall:

32 (A) Present proof of identity verification of voter  
33 registration to the election official when appearing to vote in person either  
34 early or at the polls on election day; or

35 (B) When voting by absentee ballot, submit with the ballot  
36 verification of voter registration a copy of a current and valid photo

~~identification or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement,  
government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows the name  
and address of the voter unless the voter is:~~

~~(i) A An active duty member of the uniformed  
services on active duty of the United States who is absent from the county on  
election day because of active duty his or her service;~~

~~(ii) A member of the ~~merchant marine~~ United States

22 identification when voting, is amended to read as follows:

25 ~~identification to provide proof of identity that the voter present~~  
26 verification of voter registration by providing a document or identification

14 (iii) A first-time voter who registers by mail  
15 without providing identification when registering and desires to vote in  
16 person but who does not meet the identification requirements of § 7-5-201(e)  
17 may cast a provisional ballot.

18 (iv) Following each election, the county board of  
19 election commissioners may review the precinct voter registration lists and  
20 may provide the information of the voters not ~~providing proof of identity~~  
21 presenting verification of voter registration at the polls to the prosecuting  
22 attorney.

23 (v) The county board of election commissioners shall  
24 refer suspected instances of voter fraud to the prosecuting attorney.

28 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 7-5-308 is amended to read as follows:  
29 7-5-308. Provisional ballot procedure.

30 (a) ~~When the~~ Except as provided under subsection (b) of this section,  
31 if a voter is required by law to cast a provisional ballot, the provisional  
32 ballot shall be cast pursuant to the following procedures:

33 (1) A poll worker shall notify the ~~individual voter~~ that the  
34 individual voter may cast a provisional ballot in that election;

35 (2) The voter shall execute a written eligibility affirmation  
36 under penalty of perjury in the presence of the poll worker stating that he

1 or she is a registered voter in the precinct in which he or she desires to  
2 vote and is eligible to vote;

3 (3) The poll worker shall initial the back of the provisional  
4 ballot, remove the provisional ballot stub from the provisional ballot, and  
5 place the stub in the stub box provided;

6 (4) The voter shall mark his or her provisional ballot;

7 (5) The voter shall place the voted provisional ballot in a  
8 provisional ballot secrecy envelope marked "provisional ballot" and seal the  
9 envelope;

10 (6) The voter shall place the sealed provisional ballot envelope  
11 containing the voted provisional ballot in a voter envelope, seal the  
12 envelope, and give it to the poll worker;

13 (7) The poll worker shall provide the voter written information  
14 instructing him or her on how to determine whether his or her provisional  
15 ballot was counted, and if not, the reason the provisional ballot was not  
16 counted; and

17 (8) The poll worker shall make a separate list of the names and  
18 addresses of all persons voting a provisional ballot under subsection (a) of  
19 this section, and each person voting a provisional ballot shall sign his or  
20 her name to this list.

21 (b) If a voter is required by law to cast a provisional ballot because  
22 the voter is unable to verify his or her registration by providing a document  
23 or identification card that meets the requirements of Arkansas Constitution,  
24 Amendment 51, § 13, the provisional ballot shall be cast pursuant to the  
25 following procedures:

26 (1) The poll worker shall indicate on the precinct voter  
27 registration list that the voter did not present a required document or  
28 identification card;

29 (2) The poll worker shall notify the voter that the voter may  
30 cast a provisional ballot in that election;

31 (3) The voter shall execute a written eligibility affirmation  
32 under penalty of perjury in the presence of the poll worker stating that he  
33 or she is a registered voter in the precinct in which he or she desires to  
34 vote and is eligible to vote;

35 (4)(A) The poll worker shall inform the voter that the voter may  
36 complete a sworn statement stating that the voter is registered to vote in

1 this state and that he or she is the person who is registered to vote.

2 (B) A sworn statement completed under subdivision  
3 (b)(4)(A) of this section is not required to be notarized but the voter shall  
4 execute the sworn statement under penalty of perjury.

5 (C) The sworn statement under subdivision (b)(4)(A) of  
6 this section shall be delivered to the county board of election commissioners  
7 so that the provisional ballot may be counted under subsection (f) of this  
8 section;

9 (5) The poll worker shall initial the back of the provisional  
10 ballot, remove the provisional ballot stub from the provisional ballot, and  
11 place the stub in the stub box provided;

12 (6) The voter shall mark his or her provisional ballot;

13 (7) The voter shall place the voted provisional ballot in a  
14 provisional ballot secrecy envelope marked "provisional ballot" and seal the  
15 envelope;

16 (8) The voter shall place the sealed provisional ballot envelope  
17 containing the voted provisional ballot in a voter envelope, seal the  
18 envelope, and give it to the poll worker;

19 (9) The poll worker shall provide the voter written information  
20 instructing him or her on how to determine whether his or her provisional  
21 ballot was counted, and if not, the reason the ballot was not counted; and

22 (10) The poll worker shall make a separate list of the names and  
23 addresses of all persons voting a provisional ballot under subsection (b) of  
24 this section, and each person voting a provisional ballot shall sign his or  
25 her name to this list.

26 (b)(c) The poll worker shall preserve, secure, and separate all  
27 provisional ballots under subsections (a) and (b) of this section from the  
28 remaining ballots so that the right of any person to vote may be determined  
29 later by the county board of election commissioners or the court in which an  
30 election contest may be filed.

31 (e)(1)(d)(1) Whenever a person casts a provisional ballot under this  
32 section, the poll worker shall provide the voter written information that  
33 states that the individual who casts a provisional ballot will be able to
