The Field Shop installed a complete new system in our courtroom when it was remodeled. The contractor nor county judge contacted him with an installation date. I personally reached out to him and let him know the contractor must have our courtroom completed with 2 weeks because we had to be back in the courtroom for a week-long murder trial.

Kris immediately contacted the county judge and got things moving. He came in a night and several weeks to ensure we had a sound system to start the trial. On the Saturday for the start of our trial, Kris and his team met me at the courtroom and explained exactly how to use the backup recording system and each and every one of the microphones and lapel mics.

We started the trial in a Monday morning and the sound system was new to me. I had a few questions before the trial started and throughout the day. Kris immediately responded to all of emails. We had one small issue on the second day of the trial and Kris was in our courtroom at 7:30 the next morning to fix it. He even emailed me the instruction manual for all the equipment.

He and his team have been wonderful to work for. A month later I contacted Kris to add another mic to the system and he was there within 48 hours to add it.

In the middle of another murder trial we determined we had an issue with our hearing devices. Our court security office contacted Kris one afternoon and Kris was there the next morning at 7:00 to fix it before we continued with the trial.

I cannot say enough good things about Kris and the Field Shop. In fact, we are going to add some video equipment in the courtroom and Kris will be doing that for us as well.

Kris had done the sound and recording system in another building for the county and we used the room as a temporary court for the 4 months our courtroom was being renovated. I had no issues with that equipment during that time as well.

Questions for The Field Shop

1. The queue controller (management) we believe we have figured out with a panel in the network section, but we want to confirm that there will be a queue controller at the Chair's desk (in Committee Room), Support Staff area (in Committee Room), and in the Control Room?
 1. Yes, with the Televic Confero360 license the queue controller is available in multiple locations via a web based app that can be loaded on any computer system. The control spec'd in the network section will be for the video presentation selection and room PA level control if needed.
2. As the RFP states, does your submitted quote pricing cover the support of the solution for 3 years?
 2. We included 2 years of our SLA on the proposal, so we would need to add one additional year to round out to 3 years. Wanted to make sure you received these questions responses... also a correction to the answer for question 2, the first year is included in the installation and the two years listed on the quote are for years 2 and 3, so a total of three years as requested on the RFP... Sorry for the confusion on the response, please let me know if you need any additional info... thanks!
3. If there is a critical issue with the solution, how quickly can you guarantee to be onsite?
 3. We should be able to be on-site within a maximum of 24-hours, and also login to systems remotely if needed.
4. Does the solution you proposed have the potential for being phased strategically and/or having the existing and new solutions run in parallel? We have been informed that both Committee Rooms will be available to implement from June 24th, 2024 to August 9th, 2024.
 - a. Does this window allow for a complete installation of the new solution and removal of existing? Please explain in detail.
 - b. If not, could the new solution implementation schedule honor being able to work around our monthly ALC meetings scheduled for these two rooms (a phased approach)? Our monthly ALC meetings take place on the 3rd week of each month and would need the Committee Rooms to be in working, presentable order. Please explain in detail.
 - c. If the solution is phased, what is your proposed start and finish timeline for the project, taking this information into account? Please explain in detail.

4. Based on the limited site visits it would be difficult to determine if the six week window would be enough time to complete the committee rooms. We can definitely work to create a plan to get everything installed as quickly as possible and also create a phased approach if needed. We have done this on other projects so it is not unusual. Our original estimation of the complete project timeline is 12-weeks.
5. The quoted solution was designed based off a closet location to place your equipment for Committee Room A and another dedicated for Committee Room B. If we were able to provide a new location behind the Committee Rooms that would support the equipment for both Committee Rooms in the same closet compared to the use of the existing two closets, please answer the following.
 - a. If we were to utilize the two existing closets as quoted, could you start to implement your new solution while also potentially keeping portions of the existing solution in working order if a phased approach is determined to be necessary to have the Committee Rooms up for an ALC meeting?
 - b. If we were to provide you with a new combined closet location for you to place the new equipment for Committee Rooms A/B, please answer the following.
 - i. Your cabling would now come back to one closet location instead of two. This will not change the lengths of cabling quoted greatly, but how do you see this impacting your quoted solution?
 - ii. You can combine your quoted equipment into this one space, can you provide what the rough footprint measurements the racks would require? Can you also provide the required power needs of your solution in this closet location, that we will provide?
 - iii. Please provide any additional information, questions, or changes that this type of consolidation might present or need to be answered by us.

- iv. Note: The existing quote has networking equipment and fiber going from the main MDF to each IDF location. If the Committee Rooms A/B closets are consolidated into one, we would like to still have the networking and fiber dedicated to each rooms equipment, therefore this does not change the network and/or fiber design. This does not introduce a change in architecture, just consolidation into a single closet while still maintaining management of each room within this single closet.

5. We should be able to make either the two closets or one centralized closet for equipment work. If we are awarded and move forward we would want to determine cable paths asap so we could plan for either scenario. Power requirements for the space would not be known until final design is done, but my expectation would be 2x 20amp circuits for each rack closet, or 4x 20amp circuits in the centralized closet.

- 6. If you do not have a licensed electrician on your staff, who do you plan to subcontract the high voltage electrical work to for the couple of electrical needs mentioned in the RFP?

6. We have two electrical contractors we have worked with depending on budget and availability, Staley Electric or Grounded Electric.
