Scope of Practice: Advanced emergency medical technicians: Perform focused advanced skills and pharmacological interventions that are engineered to mitigate specific life-threatening conditions with a targeted set of skills beyond the level of an EMT.

Statutory Requirement(s): A.C.A. 20-13-201 "Emergency Medical Services Act"

Scope of Practice: Emergency medical technicians: Function as part of a comprehensive EMS response with defined clinical protocols and medical oversight and perform interventions with the basic equipment typically found on an ambulance to manage life threats, medical, and psychological needs.

Scope of Practice: Paramedics: use a wide range of pharmacology, airway, and monitoring devices as well as critical thinking skills to make complex judgments such as the need for transport from a field site, alternate destination decisions, the level of personnel appropriate for transporting a patient, and similar judgments.
