- 1. Would consumers be at risk of substantial harm if Arkansas did not have this occupational authorization? What instances of specific and substantial harm have been documented in the past year?
 - Every person that is allowed on the backstretch where the horse barns are located, and every person that has any involvement in horse racing must have a license. All occupations are required to be licensed, from a horse groom to a horse owner. The ARC license requirements are the same or very similar to the license requirements at all horse racing tracks in the U.S. If the racing participants were not required to be licensed, it would possibly destroy the confidence the betting public has in the participants at Oaklawn and would possibly allow persons with no experience or who had violated the Rules in other states to participate in the race meet.
 - The ARC licensing rules which conform to the rules of all other racing
 jurisdictions have been in effect for more than 50 years. Those rules have been
 modified or changed periodically through the years but are standardized
 nationwide.
 - There have been no instances of specific or substantial harm in the last ten years or more because almost every person is licensed in more than one state.
- 2. How many complaints were made to the occupational entity by consumers being harmed by <u>unauthorized</u> practitioners? What specific action was taken by the occupational entity?
 - There have been no complaints about unauthorized persons participating in the Oaklawn Race Meet because every person is licensed and it is standard to be licensed at all race tracks.
- 3. How many complaints were made to the occupational entity by consumers being harmed by <u>authorized</u> practitioners? What specific action was taken by the occupational entity?
 - NONE.
- 4. Were any applicants who otherwise met authorization requirements denied an authorization in the past year? If so, why?
 - No.

- 5. How much does the occupational entity collect annually in fees, and what are annual expenses? How much money does the occupational entity have in reserves?
 - In 2022 the ARC collected \$184,537.00 in license fees. In 2023 the ARC has collected \$93,518.00 in license fees through September 12, 2023.
- 6. If the occupational entity has a positive amount in reserves, when was the last time reserve funds were used? For what purpose?
 - Yes, Arkansas law provides for an ARC cash fund to be used for the regulation of horse racing. That fund has not been used in 2023.
- 7. Does the occupational entity have any other sources of revenue? Could occupational authorization fees be reduced without causing the occupational entity to be underfunded?
 - The ARC receives fees from horse racing per Arkansas law and under Amendment 100 to the Arkansas Constitution which permits casino gambling. Beginning in 2024, the federal government under HISA takes over many of the former duties of the ARC. HISA will assess many of the costs to the ARC, and it is uncertain at this point in time if the ARC will have a surplus or will need additional funds. The ARC can answer this question more fully at the end of the 2023-2024 Race Meet.
- 8. How many applicants for the occupational authorization fail each year? Does the occupational entity track how many applicants that do not progress are veterans, women, or minorities?
 - There have been no complaints about applicants not receiving licenses in the past ten years. Normally, applicants are licensed in several different states. The Oaklawn Race Meet begins in December and ends on May 4 and has a total of 66 racing days. As a result, almost everyone travels to other racing jurisdictions to work during the year.
- 9. Can applicants complete the training requirements for this occupational authorization with vocational or non-traditional education (e.g., apprenticeships)? What percentage of applicants complete apprenticeships?
 - Yes. There are no formal vocational or apprenticeship programs. Most persons begin by being a helper or jockey apprentice.

- 10. In what ways would removal of the occupational authorization or reduction of occupational authorization requirements be harmful to current authorization holders?
 - There have been no complaints from licensees for many years. It would possibly affect the safety of horse racing and harm the public's confidence in pari-mutuel wagering if licenses were not required. Licenses are required in all states that engage in horse racing.
