Entity Division Name: Division of Law Enforcement Standards and Training

Scope of Practice: Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated 12-9-104, The Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training establishes the minimum selection and training standards for admission to and continuing employment as a law enforcement officer in the State of Arkansas.

The Division of Law Enforcement Standards and Training is a state agency consisting of two branches that ensure compliance with the selection and training standards set by the Commission. The Office of Law Enforcement Standards ensures compliance with the selection criteria set by the Commission, including minimum education requirements, criminal record checks, continuing education requirements, and approving certification requests. The Arkansas Law Enforcement Training Academy (ALETA) has three locations that conduct basic and specialized training throughout the year.

Statutory Requirement(s): As determined by the Arkansas Legislature in Arkansas Code Annotated 12-9-101, it is in public interest that minimum levels of education and training be developed and made available to persons seeking to become law enforcement officers and to persons presently serving as law enforcement officers.

Arkansas Code Annotated 12-9-104 requires the Commission to promulgate rules associated with the minimum selection and training standards for law enforcement officers, including those standards set in Arkansas Code Annotated 12-9-106.

Pursuant to Arkansas Code § 17-1-106, do you provide automatic licensure to an active military service member, returning military veteran applying for licensure within one year of his or her discharge from active duty, or the spouse of an active military service member or returning military veteran who is within one year of discharge from active duty?
