Scope of Practice: A registered or certified abstracter is authorized to certify an abstract of title, which is a compilation in chronological order of the materials and facts of record affecting the title to a specific piece of land. It is a more in-depth historical instrument than a title search or a title policy.

Statutory Requirement(s): Arkansas Code 17-11-301(b) requires a person to be a registered abstracter in order to execute an abstract certificate or otherwise attest to the accuracy of an abstract
