State of Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board**COMMERCIAL CONTRACTOR**Authorization Type: Licensure # of Individuals Regulated:

Entity Division Name: Contractors Licensing Board, Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing Boards and Commissions, Department of Labor and Licensing.

Scope of Practice: Contracting business performing construction work on projects other than single family residences, when the project being performed by the contractor is \$50,000 or more. The Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board licenses construction business, not individual workers. No worker is required to have a license. Some business applicants are Sole Proprietorships. For commercial contractors, the Board currently licenses 7,610 construction business. Of those, 142 are Sole Proprietorships, the remaining are corporations, LLCs, partnerships, etc.

Statutory Requirement(s): Ark. Code Ann. section 17-25-101 et seq.

Authorization Type: Licensure # of Individuals Regulated:

Entity Division Name: Contractors Licensing Board, Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing Boards and Commissions, Department of Labor and Licensing.

Scope of Practice: A construction business building a new single family residence or performing other types of construction work on a single family residence, where the cost of the project is more than \$2,000. The Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee licenses construction business, not individual workers. No worker is required to have a license. Some business applicants are Sole Proprietorships. For Residential Builders, the Committee currently licenses 2,288 construction business. Of those, 613 are Sole Proprietorships, the remaining are corporations, LLCs, partnerships, etc.

Statutory Requirement(s): Ark, Code Ann. section 17-25-505.

Authorization Type: Licensure # of Individuals Regulated:

Entity Division Name: Contractors Licensing Board, Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing Boards and Commissions, Department of Labor and Licensing.

Scope of Practice: A construction business performing construction, as a prime contractor, on a single family residence, where the contractors portion of the project is more than \$2,000. If working as a subcontractor to a licensed contractor, no license is required. The Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee licenses construction business, not individual workers. No worker is required to have a license. Some business applicants are Sole Proprietorships. For residential Home Improvement contractors, the Committee currently licenses 4,355 construction business. Of those, 2,614 are Sole Proprietorships, the remaining are corporations, LLCs, partnerships, etc.

Authorization Type: Licensure # of Individuals Regulated:

Entity Division Name: Contractors Licensing Board, Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing Boards and Commissions, Department of Labor and Licensing.

Scope of Practice: Construction Business performing construction work on a single family residence in excess of \$2,000. This classification can perform all types of construction up to and including additions to an existing home. The Arkansas Residential Contractors Committee licenses construction business, not individual workers. No worker is required to have a license. Some business applicants are Sole Proprietorships. For Residential Remodeling contractors, the Board currently licenses 2,084 construction business. Of those, 1,498 are Sole Proprietorships, the remaining are corporations, LLCs, partnerships, etc.
