Dear Dr. Markham:

Please consider this formal request for East Arkansas Community College to issue a 2.8% cost of living adjustment (COLA) and a merit increase, also averaging 2.8%, for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. As part of this COLA, faculty members will receive a \$1,200 increase to the faculty salary scale as well as a one-time \$700 bonus. This increase was approved unanimously by the college's Board of Trustees on May 19, 2022. With current inflation rates exceeding 8%, it is critical that the college allow for a COLA of greater than 2% in an effort to remain relevant with current economic conditions.

East Arkansas Community College has budgeted for a 4.71% increase in unrestricted revenue for the 2022-2023 fiscal year due to an increase in productivity funding as well as a \$3 increase in mandatory fees. Due to planned administrative restructuring, East Arkansas Community College will only recognize a 0.56% increase in personnel expenses as a result of the 2.8% COLA and merit categories (attached). This small expense combined with the projected increase in revenue allows the college the ability to provide a merit increase and a COLA of greater than 2% for the 2022-2023 fiscal year.

As President of East Arkansas Community College, I certify that the college maintains a sufficient budget for funding the aforementioned COLA and merit.
