In accordance with Act 778 of 2023, ACA § 6-63-319, Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas (UA Cossatot) is respectfully requesting a total of four (4) non-classified positions from the Division of Higher Education Central Pool. The positions are one (1) Project/Program Director and (3) Project/Program Managers.

With UA Cossatot's Athletic Programs growth, and no appropriate vacant positions, it is vital this request be made.

If approved, our Athletic Director will be moved from his current Provisional position to the Project/Program Director's position, leaving the Academic Advisor/Coach Provisional position open, to be surrendered in the 24-25 Provisional Position Continuation request.

The Assistant/Associate Basketball Coach and the Head Soccer Coach will be moved to Project/Program Manager's positions, leaving our Special Instructor/Trainer positions vacant at this time.

The plan for the remaining Project/Program Manager position is to hire a second full-time Soccer Coach or Assistant beginning January 2024.

This past year was the first year for Colts Basketball ad already the teams have a history of winning, with the women finishing 12-11 and the men 13-15! The position reports directly to the Chancellor, informing of all planning, organizing, and development of UA Cossatot's men's and women's basketball program. This is a 12-month position that renews annually.
