JUSTIFICATION

The Division of Shared Services is requesting three (3) Surrender Pool positions and two (2) new titles due to reorganization and the need to strengthen the department's legal team. The new title of Agri Law Enforcement Deputy Chief, GS09, is needed as a result of the passage of Act 636 and the creation of the Office of Agricultural Intelligence which the current law enforcement team is having difficulty managing due to the growing number of violations already investigated. The current Law Enforcement Assistant Chief will laterally move into the new title of Agri Investigator II. The Agri Investigator, GS07, is needed to bring positions into better alignment and more accurately reflect the job duties. The incumbent of one surrendered position (22094773) would be promoted into this

position with the standard 10% increase. Approval of these requests will result in an anticipated cost of approximately \$18,396, including matching, and will be paid from general revenue.

The Division of Agriculture is requesting one (1) Surrender Pool position to better align the positions within the Forestry division and accurately reflect the job duties and responsibilities. The current incumbent occupying the position to be surrendered (22088650) will promote into the new position and receive the standard 10% increase in salary. Approval of this request will result in an anticipated cost of approximately \$9,179, including matching, and will be paid from general revenue.

The Office of Personnel Management has reviewed the request and **recommends** the approval of four (4) Surrender Pool positions and two (2) new titles. The maximum cost for all pool positions would be approximately \$27,575, considering two positions would be promotions for existing employees, from general revenue.

Dear Ms. Barnhill:

The Arkansas Department of Agriculture is seeking to obtain the following three new positions for Business Area 9901 from the surrender pool. If the new positions are approved, the Department will refrain from filling three positions until the next biennium when they will be surrendered in a show of good faith and to reduce costs.

Managing Attorney - GS13

The Department is requesting a GS13 Managing Attorney position for better alignment of job duties and responsibilities, and to improve the Department's ability to recruit more qualified candidates. This position will strengthen the Department's legal team and its ability to handle a broad and extensive workload.

Agri Law Enforcement Deputy Chief (New Title) - GS09

This position is needed to better align responsibilities within the Department's five-person law enforcement team that has assumed vitally important and time sensitive statewide responsibilities with the passage of Act 636 and the creation of the Office of Agricultural intelligence. While the Department's law enforcement team is actively reviewing a significant number of potential Act 636 violations, the law enforcement team has already assisted with actions to compel the removal of Chinese owned Syngenta Seeds in Northeast Arkansas and has assisted with formally reporting two additional potential violations of Act 636 by Chinese entities to the Arkansas Attorney General this year. These responsibilities are in addition to the normal statewide workload of the team which includes assisting with arson, illegal dumping, vandalism, agricultural theft, and assistance to other Department of Agriculture activities. The addition of another law enforcement officer to the team will allow the Department to better manage the normal day to day workload of agricultural crimes while also devoting additional attention to the significant issue of unlawful foreign ownership.

Agri Investigator - GS07

This position is needed to bring one of the Department's law enforcement positions into alignment with other law enforcement positions within the Department and more accurately reflect job duties. Incumbent Keith Dedmon is currently in an Administrative Analyst position (GS06 #22094773) that was cross-graded to a GS06 Law Enforcement Training Instructor. Mr. Dedmon would promote to the GS07 position with no change in salary.

These positions are paid from general revenue. If approved, the new positions would result in a total estimated cost of \$18,396 to the agency.

The Department proposes to refrain from filling the following vacant positions:

- GS11 22087644 Attorney Specialist
- GS11 22179628 Attorney Specialist
- GS06 22094773 Administrative Analyst/cross graded to Law Enforcement Training Instructor (Currently occupied by incumbent Keith Dedmon, who would transfer to the new GS07 Investigator with no change in salary).

The Department also requests a new title for the current GS08 22163449 Agri Law Enforcement Assistant Chief to Agri Investigator II. The Agri Investigator II position would assist with the Office of Agricultural Intelligence workload while also assisting with the law enforcement team's normal statewide workload. The current incumbent will transfer to the Agri Investigator II position with no change in salary.
