RECOMMENDATION

ASUN states that the total compensation for the positions requested is \$63,500 - \$69,850.

In accordance with Act 778 of 2023, ACA § 6-63-319, Arkansas State University-Newport Community College of the Arkansas State University System is respectfully requesting a total of two (2) non-classified positions from the Division of Higher Education Surrender Pool. Justification:

As Arkansas State University-Newport continues to grow our Athletic Programs, we are anticipating we will bring approximately 40 student athletes to campus in Fall 2024. Fall 2023 has been our initial year to start athletics. We have a men's basketball team and a women's softball team. The Athletic Trainer position will be essential to our programs, it is a priority of our institution to be invested in the success and welfare of our athletes. The Athletic Trainer will evaluate athletes' condition, establish plans for diet, fitness, and treatment, and track progress towards health and fitness goals.

In order to request this position, we would like to surrender a vacant Administrative Support Pool position, Line Item #28, from our ACT 375 of the Regular Session, Senate Bill 104.



Educational Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in athletic training and a valid state license or certification
- Proven education and experience working with individual athletes and teams
- Strong understanding of the challenges athletes face, proper nutrition, sports injuries, and treatment options
- Understanding of first-aid treatments, massage, and physical therapy techniques and equipment
- Detail oriented, analytical, and attentive
- Excellent interpersonal, problem solving, decision making, and communication skills.

Duties:

Duties and Responsibilities include:

- Provides game/event and practice coverage for all Arkansas State University-Newport sports programs as assigned by the Athletic Director
- Establishes good rapport with the coaches, staff, and students as well as the communities served
- Will work cooperatively with coaches, students, and others with respect to the following: rehabilitation, operation and use of therapeutic devices and equipment, the application of braces, guards, tape, and bandages
- Supervises correct performance of training techniques in collaboration with coaches
- Aid athletes with any sports care service that is feasible
- Exhibit knowledge of sports-related injuries to diagnose and treat athletes
- Refers athletes to other medical staff members when necessary
- Maintaining records relating to athlete condition and training, diet, and treatment plans
- Other duties as assigned

Justification:

Arkansas State University-Newport started the Athletic Programs in fiscal year 2023, set to bring approximately 40 athletes in Fall 2024. This position will ensure our programs are effective in recruiting and retaining student athlete talent as well as coaching talent, compliance with NJCAA guidelines, and the leader in fundraising for athletics. This request would assist in building sustainable Athletic Programs.

In order to request this position, we would like to surrender a vacant Administrative Support Pool position, Line Item #28, from our ACT 375 of the Regular Session, Senate Bill 104.



Educational Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in sports management or related field preferred with at least five years of coaching experience.
- Must demonstrate high energy and friendliness to employees, students, and external stakeholders.
- Must have knowledge of the Microsoft Office Suite.
- Must have demonstrated fundraising experience.

Duties:

The Athletic Director/Coach will be responsible for maintaining the programs established by Arkansas State University-Newport. This past year was the first year of Aviator Softball and Basketball. This position will report directly to the Chancellor, informing of all planning, organizing, and development of ASUN athletic programs. This is a 12-month position that renews annually.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide leadership and guidance for sports activities and programs
- Supervise purchase and maintenance of athletic equipment and facilities
- Ensure compliance with government rules and league policies
- Act as a liaison with selectors, leagues, and government agencies
- Coordinate with Coaches on team travel, game scheduling, and practice sessions
- Prepare and present reports on team performance and needs for improvement
- Mediate any disputes between Coaches and Athletes
- Develop fundraisers to support athletic programs
- Assist in providing academic advising and track academic progress of all players
- Serve as Athletic Director and Official Voting Member of the NJCAA
