Purpose of Grant / Reason for addition or change: (include attachments as necessary to provide thorough information):
The purpose of this cooperative agreement is to secure 3 additional archaeologists support for NRCS in implementing Farm Bill Programs (EQIP, CSP, RCPP. CIG, ACEP and CRP). Due to the high number of Farm Bill applicants in FY17, current NRCS archaeological staff are experiencing delays in processing cultural resource reviews and completing associated field reviews. In an effort to ensure prompt service to farm Bill participants additional archaeologists are needed to service cultural resource requests from NRCS field offices. The Arkansas Agriculture Department has agreed, through this cooperative agreement, to hire 3 qualified archaeologists to assist Arkansas NRCS with processing cultural resource requests during FY19, FY 20 and FY21. These positions will ensure that Arkansas Farm Bill Participants receive timely processing of Farm Bill applications and contracts thus supporting

In Arkansas the majority of surface drinking water originates in forested watersheds. Protecting those sources of drinking water is by and large a matter of conserving the forest land cover in the watershed. The purpose of this grant is to provide better protection of drinking water sources in forest watersheds through improved forest management, stand improvement, reforestation, and afforestation. Two new foresters are to be hired to complete the technical assistance tasks required of the grants. Their responsibilities include forest assessment, consultation with the landowner on property objectives, developing forest management/reforestation plans, assisting with implementation and also assisting with applications for financial assistance.

Purpose of Grant / Reason for addition or change: (include attachments as necessary to provide thorough information):
The Division of Workforce Services, IANF program (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) will collaborate with Adult Education to provide assessment, education/training, and skill development to low-income individuals in Arkansas. Restore Hope, a program created by Governor Hutchison, will also be a collaborative partner. Adult Education and Restore Hope will provide services to exoffenders to improve the employment skills and family connections of parents who leave state jails and prisons.

Due to increasing demand, this program is expanding from two to eight counties and will be serving over three thousand reentry individuals and other TANF eligible dients. This growth requires additional personnel to manage the program effectively. Since the TANF reoures specific renortino and management. the acred to reimburse Adult Education $100 \%$ for the operations personnel.

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Purpose of Grant , Reason for addition or change: (include attachments as necessary to provide thorough informat on):
The Arkansas Department of Heath (ADH) has been awarded an Overdose Data to Action Program grant in the amount of $\$ 3,517,401$ for year 1 and funding is expected to total $\$ 10,552,203$ over a period of 3 years. The grant is managed by the Substance Misuse and Injury Prevention Branch within the Center for Health Protection. This will fund the projects related to increased ease of use of the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program and education for prescribers, opioid misuse and drug overdose surveillance and prevention, linkages to care for substance use disorder, education and awareness of the opioid crisis, and support to partners like the AR Crime Lab and the AR Drug Director.




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With OPI8-1815 funding, the ADH Chronic Disease Prevention and Control Branch in collaboration with key partners will build on the accomplishments and outcomes of the 1305 grant using a mult-pronged approach to improve diabetes and cardiovascular disease outcomes among Arkansans. Diabetes management and type 2 diabetes prevention strategies include: increased partiopation in ADA-recognized/ AADE-accredited OSMES programs in underserved areas (A.1); OSMES coverage policy among employers (A.2); identification of people with prediabetes and referral to OPs (A.4); collaboration with payers to expand Op as la covered benefit for ADH employees (A.5); and DPP enrollment strategies (A.6). Cardiovascular disease prevention and management strategies include: increased adoption and use of electronic health records (EHR) and health information technology (HIT) to improve provider and patient heath outcomes for undiagnosed and diagnosed hypertension ( 8.1 ); adoptions




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
