The Office of Personnel Management submits a second language compensation differential request from the Arkansas State Police (ASP) in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §21-5-221(j).

ASP requests continuation of previously approved second language differentials for Fiscal Year 2018 based on the following levels of proficiency:

| A. Advanced        | 10%  |
|--------------------|------|
| B. Fluent          | 7.5% |
| C. Intermediate    | 5.0% |
| D. Beginning/Basic | 2.0% |

Individuals receiving the differential must pass oral and written proficiency examinations. The second language must be utilized at least 25% of the time in performing job duties. Employees receiving the differential whose job duties change and no longer require the use of the second language will no longer receive the differential. Second language differentials are not considered part of an employee's base pay. ASP had four incumbents receiving second language differentials in Fiscal Year 2017. The total cost to the agency in fiscal year 2017 was \$10,481.
